Day 1 Zagreb

Day **2** Zagreb Ljubljana

Discover the highlights of its historic center, including the charming Central open-air Market, the iconic Three Bridges, the impressive Baroque Town Hall, and the marvelous Robba's Fountain.

Day **3** Ljubljana Bled Plitvice

After having breakfast, the next stop is **Bled**, a small town in the Julian Alps that ranks among the most beautiful alpine resorts. It's like a scene from a fairy tale, with mountains and forests surrounding an emerald glacial lake. Visit to the **Bled Castle**, which is the oldest in Slovenia.

After our visit to Bled, we will proceed to the captivating **Plitvice lakes**. Once we arrive in the evening, we will have the pleasure of indulging in a delightful dinner.

Day **4**

Plitvice Split

After breakfast, we will take a morning tour of the **Plitvice lakes**. Walk around this well-known UNESCO World Heritage Site, the natural beauty of the 16 crystal-blue lakes cascading into 92 spectacular waterfalls.

Your journey continues to **Split**, where your guide will reveal the hidden treasures of Diocletian's Palace, a UNESCO-protected site and its cellar. Over the course of the Middle Ages, the original palace underwent modifications by its residents, resulting in its enhanced beauty and the establishment of its significance as the pulsating heart of the city.

In the evening, enjoy a delightful dinner in Split.

Overnight stay in Split at **Hotel Corner** or similar.

Split Pelješac Dubrovnik

After breakfast, we'll head towards **Dubrovnik**.

Stroll along the city's marble streets, marvel at its baroque architecture, and savor the endless beauty of the Adriatic
