Zagreb Varaždin & Trakoscan Zagreb

As the dreamy sceneries of vineyards and rural landscapes replace the image of the bustling capital city, travel to **Varazdin**, the northern region's center. Known for the distinct Baroque air, Varazdin sits on the bank of river Drava and weaves its green parks and flat lands around the Baroque and rococo architectural fabric.

From Varazdin, make your way to one of the most beautiful **Croatian castles, Trakoscan**, with a known history dating back to the 14th century. According to one legend, Trakošćan owes its name to a Thrace fort (arx Thacorum) that allegedly existed in the ancient times. Another legend says that it got its name after the Drachenstein knights who ruled this area in the early Middle Ages. Trakošćan is one of the rare objects in Croatia with fully preserved construction, historically tied to the architectural frame and life of its owners- the Drašković family. Enjoy traditional lunch in Vuglec Breg, located between beautiful green hills, in the heart of Zagorje.

At the end of the tour (approx 6 hours) return to Zagreb, and, the remainder of the day is at leisure,

Day 4 Zagreb Plitvice Lakes National Park Zagreb

After breakfast, depart to Croatia's most popular national park, situated south of Zagreb. As you drive away from the bustling city landscapes, relax as they turn into rural imagery embraced in green forests. You are headed to 16 cascading lakes which overflow in a spectacular play of over 90 waterfalls, creating the UNESCO-listed **Plitvice Lakes National Park**. Your guide will explain the inspiring works of nature behind the beauty of Plitvice and you will have a chance to not only walk around, but **enjoy panoramic boat and train rides**.

After some time on your own, head back to Zagreb for a relaxing evening on your own.
