This luxurious five-star train features both Luxury and De Luxe suites, where guests enjoy gourmet cuisine, fine South African wines and attentive service from personal Butlers available at all hours. The experience blends comfort and sophistication, whether in-suite or in the stylish lounges. A highlight includes an off-train stop in Kimberley to visit the Big Hole and the Diamond Museum, subject to weather conditions.

Day 1

Pretoria Station

The journey begins at 10:00am with guest check-in at Irene Country Lodge, Autograph Collection, where pre-departure beverages and canapés are served. From 11:30am, shuttles transport guests to Irene Station, with boarding commencing at 11:45am. Upon arrival, personal Butlers welcome guests and escort them to their suites.

The Blue Train departs at 12:00pm, followed by a suite orientation. At 13:00pm, a light lunch is served in the Lounge and Observation Cars. Dinner - a formal affair, is served in two sittings - followed by post-dinner drinks, Cognacs and Cuban cigars in the Club Car.

Lunch, Dinner



Kimberley Station

The day begins with breakfast served between 07:00am and 10:00am on a first-come-first-served basis.

At 10:00am, The Blue Train arrives at Kimberley Station for an off-the-train excursion (weather and time permitting). Guests disembark and are transferred by bus from the Railway Museum to the Kimberley Open Mine Museum. Later, a guided tour takes guests through historical sites and onto an enclosed ramp overlooking the famous Big Hole. By midday, guests return to the station where they're welcomed with a glass of sherry—served in a keepsake glass engraved with The Blue Train logo. The train departs Kimberley at 12:30pm, resuming its journey to Cape Town. Guests may then refresh and enjoy aperitifs in the lounges. Lunch is served in two sittings, followed by High Tea at in the afternoon. Dinner is served in two formal sittings, with guests invited to enjoy post-dinner drinks, Cognacs and Cuban cigars in the Club Car.

Cape Town Station

The morning begins with a leisurely breakfast, served on a first-come-first-served basis. Later in the day, guests can enjoy a light lunch in the elegant Lounge and Observation Cars while taking in the final scenic views. As the journey concludes, The Blue Train arrives at Cape Town Station between 3:00pm - 6:00pm, where personal Butlers escort guests to the Arrival Lounge. *Please note that all timings are subject to change.*
