ITINERARY

Day

1

Airport Negombo

Arrival in Sri Lanka / Meet & Greet at the airport where you will meet your private guide.

You will then proceed to Negombo in your private car (approximately 30 minutes travel time) and check in at the resort. Later in the afternoon Explore the fishing Village and evening enjoy a BBQ Cooking session (Approx 2 hrs) (Type of spices and cooking methods differ from one location to the other).

Spend the rest of the evening at leisure.

Overnight stay in Negombo at **Heritage Negombo** in a Deluxe Room.



Day **2**

Negombo Sigiriya

Enjoy breakfast at the resort.

You'll head to **Sigiriya** (approximately 4 hours travel time). You'll then proceed to the beautiful **Sigiriya Rock Fortress**. It consists of 1200 steps. The first part of the visit is a leisurely walk through the pleasure gardens. Then one starts to climb. There are two areas where one can take a break on the way up. The entire duration of the experience takes approximately 1.5 to 2.5 hours depending on the speed at which you want to climb. Check in at the resort and enjoy the afternoon at your own leisure.

Sigiriya Hiriwadunna Sigiriya

Enjoy breakfast before a fascinating 3-hour **Sri Lankan village** experience in Hiriwadunna. The journey includes a boat

ride, tractor tour through paddy fields, and visits to plantations showcasing traditional farming. Along the way, savor refreshing stops for fruit slices and herbal drinks. End the tour with a cooking demonstration and a hearty meal served on lotus leaves.

Passikudah Kandv

Enjoy breakfast at the resort.

Then travel for 4 hours heading to Kandy - a **UNESCO World Heritage site**. First, you'll visit **Sri Dalada Maligawa** or also known as the **Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic**. It is located in the royal palace complex which houses the relic of the tooth of Buddha. The visit typically lasts 1 hour. First you walk towards the temple through the gardens. Your guide will buy you the entrance tickets. We recommend buying a lotus flower right at the entrance – 100 LKR per set. Your guide will walk you through the various chambers explaining the history and significance of the temple.

Check in at the resort in Kandy and spend the rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight stay in Kandy at **Cinnamon Citadel** in a Superopr Room.
