Continue your route visiting Plaza de Platerías, presided over by the Fuente de los Caballos, building of the University of Santiago, and Calle del Franco, one of the most popular tapas areas in the city. You will finish the tour by returning to the Plaza del Obradoiro and visiting the inside of the Cathedral.

Free afternoon to enjoy this wonderful city and discover the wonders of its gastronomy.
