

Day 1

Dublin Glasson

Guests are met in Dublin and transferred by private chauffeured minibus to the Shannon Princess. Day 2

Glasson Athlone

This morning, begin your cruise around the beautiful 'inner lakes' (islands) of **Lough Ree**, passing stately homes and lush forested islands. You'll then continue north as you explore some of the 365 islands on the lake. You will then circle back to the River Shannon and onto your mooring in **Athlone Town**. After lunch you will visit the **Kilbeggan Whiskey Distillery**.

Day 3

Athlone Shannonbridge

Today's journey takes you through Athlone Lock and southwards across Europe's finest example of "Callow" landscape. The vessel moors at **Clonmacnoise**, the famous 6th-century university and early monastic settlement, where a guided tour is offered. Afterward, the cruise continues to Shannonbridge. Following lunch, there is a visit to **Leap Castle**, reputedly Ireland's most haunted house. Guests enjoy a personal tour from the castle's eccentric owner, Sean Ryan, who, accompanied by traditional Irish musicians, shares the fascinating history of the castle and its connection to the founding of the American Constitution. Dinner is served on board.

Shannonbridge Terryglass

This morning's cruise follows a picturesque stretch of the River Shannon through Meelick Lock, pausing as Portumna swing bridge opens to allow passage onto the idyllic Lough Derg, before mooring at Terryglass Harbour. In the afternoon, there is a visit to **Birr Castle** to explore the magnificent gardens, the intriguing Science Centre, and the historic Great Telescope. Dinner is served on board.

Terryglass Mountshannon

The day begins with a visit to the walled gardens of **Portumna Castle**, followed by a tour of Galway, a vibrant university city and cultural centre of the Irish-speaking west. Guests can explore crystal, craft, and linen shops before enjoying lunch at a traditional Guinness and oyster pub. The cruise continues across scenic Lough Derg, passing Forrest Park and ancient mountains, before mooring at Mountshannon, a charming lakeside village overlooking the lough. Dinner is served on board during the sunset cruise.

Day **6**

Mountshannon Killaloe

The journey continues across the southern part of Lough Derg, rejoining the River Shannon to moor at Killaloe, historically home to the court of Brian Boru, Ireland's greatest High King. After exploring this elegant town, lunch is served on board before a visit to Adare Manor, an impressive estate on the banks of the River Maigue. Guests experience a falconry demonstration (weather dependent) in the Walled Garden, observing owls, falcons, and eagles up close. The afternoon concludes with a visit to a traditional Irish hand-weaving workshop, followed by a 'Sláinte' cocktail reception and the **Captain's Farewell Dinner** on board.
