## Toronto Niagara Falls Toronto

## Toronto   Ottawa | VIA Rail

This morning, transfer independently to Union Station to board VIA Rail's The Corridor train to Ottawa. Upon arrival in Ottawa, the remainder of the day is free to explore the charms of Canada's capital city. Take a stroll along the famous Rideau Canal (designated by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site) or discover what the bustling Byward Market has to offer.

## Ottawa

You will see the Parliament Buildings, Embassy Row, the Royal Canadian Mint, the National Gallery of Canada, the National Aviation Museum, the residence of the Prime Minister and Governor-General, the RCMP Museum and Stables, the National Arts Centre and much more. You will drive through scenic gardens and parklands and along the Rideau Canal. This comprehensive sightseeing tour is special as it allows you to step on and off at any of the stops along the route to fully experience the charming nation's capital. ## Fairmont Royal York

### Toronto

Occupying a circa-1929 building retaining original features such as hand-painted ceilings and travertine pillars, this upscale hotel is a 13-minute walk from the CN Tower and 1 km from the Harbourfront Centre. There are 4 restaurants and bars, including a refined lounge serving afternoon tea. There's also a spa with a 24/7 gym, an indoor pool and a whirlpool tub.



## Fairmont Chateau Laurier

### Ottawa

Occupying a grand limestone property overlooking the Rideau Canal, this upscale hotel is a 7-minute walk from the National Gallery of Canada, and less than a kilometre from Parliament Hill. Amenities include a refined restaurant and a cocktail lounge, in addition to an indoor pool and a gym.



## Le Saint-Sulpice Hotel

### Montreal

This high-end, all-suite hotel is adjacent to the Notre-Dame Basilica of Montreal, and a 6-minute walk from both the Vieux-Port and Place-d'Armes Metro station. The elegant suites include living rooms and kitchenettes, and some have views of Notre-Dame. Amenities include a glass-enclosed restaurant, a lobby bar and a courtyard garden.
