Strasbourg

Upon arrival at Strasbourg Train Station or Airport you will be escorted by private transfer to your centrally located hotel and check in.

Overnight stay in Strasbourg at **Le Grand Hotel Strasbourg**.

Strasbourg Wine region Strasbourg

After breakfast, meet your English speaking driver-guide at Strasbourg Tourism Office on Cathedral Square and start your small group **Alsace wine tour**.

Discover the Enchanting Alsace Wine Route: Embark on a full-day exploration of the world-famous Alsace Wine Route, a captivating 170-kilometer stretch along the Vosges Mountains. Immerse yourself in the breathtaking beauty and historical significance of this renowned French Wine Region. Traverse rolling vineyards and discover the medieval charm of quaint villages.

Unveil the Secrets of Alsace Wines: Our small-group tour begins with a scenic drive along the iconic Wine Route. Your expert guide will lead you to exquisite Alsace villages for tastings of a wide range of wines, including Grands Crus. Savor the flavors of Pinot Gris, Gewürztraminer, Rieslings, Sylvaner, and more. At each local cellar, personalized commentary by a family member or the cellar master ensures a deep understanding of the region's winemaking expertise.

Immerse Yourself in Alsace's Beauty & Culture: Continue your journey with a visit to renowned landmarks like Riquewihr, where you'll have time for exploration and lunch. Your small group tour offers further opportunities for wine

Day **3**

Strasbourg Eguisheim & Riquewihr Strasbourg

After breakfast, meet your English speaking driver-guide at Strasbourg Tourism Office on Cathedral Square and start your small group **tour to beautiful towns, villages and amazing landscapes**.

Our first stop is the charming village of Eguisheim, nestled amidst rolling vineyards. Explore its narrow, concentric streets adorned with vibrantly decorated half-timbered houses, each adding to the village's traditional Alsatian charm.

After a walk in the village, your tour then continues on to the beautiful town of **Riquewihr**. Surrounded by ramparts, the village has been very fortunate to survive war and destruction. Its tiny streets, fortified walls and old houses have preserved their 16th Century splendor virtually intact, making for remarkable architectural harmony.

Free time for personal discovery and lunch (own expenses).

After lunch, enjoy the spectacular **Alsace Wine Route**. Located between the Rhine Valley and the Vosges mountain range, the 60-year-old route winds across the slopes for more than 170kms. The itinerary leads across rows of undulating, vine covered hills, and through quaint villages with narrow streets and charming flower decked houses clustered around the local church steeple. On this part of your day trip from Strasbourg, your guide will stop in several areas for great photo opportunities.

Finally, reach the mighty **Haut Koenigsbourg Castle**. Here, follow your guide for a tour of this mighty fortress that overlooks the valley. Built in the 12th century, the Castle occupied a strategic position controlling the wine and wheat routes to the north and the salt route that came from the East. The castle is probably the most imposing of all the Alsace region. After the visit, return to Strasbourg.

The rest of the evening is at leisure.

Overnight stay in Strasbourg at **Le Grand Hotel Strasbourg**.
