ITINERARY

Rome Assisi Siena Florence

Depart at 7:15 a.m. by deluxe coach to **Assisi**, a medieval town surrounded by ancient walls. Visit the Basilica of St. Francis, featuring frescoes by Giotto and Cimabue and enjoy a lunch in Assisi.

Continue to Siena, UNESCO-listed and famous for its shell-shaped Piazza del Campo and Palio horse race. Next, you will continue to Florence, where you will check in at your hotel.

Overnight stay in Florence at Hotel Raffaello or similar.

§ 2 Florence

Explore Florence, cradle of the Renaissance. Visit the **Duomo**, **Brunelleschi's Dome**, **Giotto's Bell Tower**, and **Baptistery**. See **Piazza della Signoria**, **Palazzo Vecchio**, and **Santa Croce Basilica**. Enjoy lunch in a traditional Tuscan restaurant.

In the afternoon, choose between free time in the city or an optional visit to Pisa, with its Leaning Tower and Piazza dei Miracoli.

Dinner is at leisure.

Overnight stay in Florence at Hotel Raffaello or similar.

Depart for **Bologna** and enjoy a walking tour through its arcaded streets, visiting **Piazza Maggiore**, the **Basilica of San Petronio**, and historic landmarks.

§ 5 Mestre Montepulciano Rome

Depart Venice and travel through Tuscany to **Montepulciano**, a hilltop town known for "Vino Nobile" and stunning views. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, paired with a glass of fine Tuscan wine.

After lunch, take some free time before heading back to Rome, where the tour concludes.

After breakfast, get ready for an exciting excursion to the island of **Capri**: one of the most exclusive summer destinations of the Mediterranean! Depending on the weather and sea conditions, you will admire the dreamy **Blue Grotto** on a small rowboat.

Afterward, time to roam the island at your own pace.

Once back on the mainland, return to the hotel for dinner and your last overnight in Sorrento.

Overnight stay in Sorrento at **Grand Hotel Vesuvio** or similar.

Depart for **Pompeii** and enjoy a guided tour of the archaeological site with skip-the-line access and headsets.

After the visit, transfer to Naples port and board the overnight ferry to Palermo.

§ 12 Palermo

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, and then head out on a morning excursion to **Monreale**, recently included on the UNESCO World Heritage List, an ancient royal town famous for its almonds, olive oil, and citrus fruits, as well as for its fine Norman architecture. Visit the elaborate **Cathedral of Monreale** and then enjoy shopping at the local delicatessen and souvenirs.

Back to **Palermo** and continue with a walking tour of the city. Wander the streets of the Old Town, hearing tales of Palermo's 3,000- year history and discovering attractions like **Palermo Cathedral**. Walk inside the impressive-looking place of worship and marvel at its arches, cupolas, and mosaics - with an incredible mix of influences coming from several dominations on the island. Enjoy free time in the late afternoon.

Dinner at the hotel is included.

Overnight stay in Palermo at Mercure Palermo Centro or similar.

§ 13 Palermo Erice Marsala Agrigento

Travel to **Erice**, a well-preserved medieval village with ancient charm. Continue to Marsala for a light lunch and wine tasting in a traditional winery. After this flavorful experience, head to **Agrigento**.

Visit the **Valley of the Temples**, a UNESCO site, and explore ruins like the **Temple of Concord**, **Hercules**, **and Jupiter**. Check in to your hotel.

Dinner at the hotel is included.

Overnight stay in Agrigento at Hotel Della Valle or similar.

Drive to **Ragusa** and visit the charming Ibla district. Be enchanted by the elegant **Cathedral of San Giorgio**, the Church of the Souls in Purgatory, and the magnificent **Cosentini palace**, one of the most interesting Late Baroque palaces in Sicily!

Overnight stay in Ragusa at Hotel Poggio del Sole or similar.

In the late afternoon, arrive in Taormina, check in to your hotel, and enjoy dinner.

Breakfast at the hotel and travel to **Noto**, a picturesque fishing town popular for its stately Baroque architecture. After the visit, cross one of the city's bridges to visit the island of **Ortygia** - the most ancient part of Syracuse - home to a wealth of Baroque churches and medieval palaces.

Arrive in Taormina and check-in to your hotel.

Overnight stay in Taormina at **Splendid Hotel Taormina** or similar.

Breakfast, Dinner



316 Taormina Mount Etna Taormina

Breakfast at your hotel and then head off to **Mount Etna**, the largest active volcano in Europe and the highest mountain in Italy. Learn about volcanic activity and marvel at the old lava fields and black magma rock that comprises Etna's landscape. If weather permits, you have a chance to climb to the summit (1800m).

Lastly, return to Taormina, the beautiful and romantic town on **Mount Tauro**. Return to Taormina in the afternoon and spend the rest of your day at leisure.


