Day 3: Half Day Tour of Sintra, Cabo de Roca, Cascais

Depart at 14.30hours and enjoy a half day in this picturesque region known for its historic architecture, lush landscapes, and romantic atmosphere. Sintra is famous for its stunning palaces and castles. Let yourself be surprised by the Sintra National Palace located in the center of the village of Sintra, this Palace is known for its historical, architectural and artistic value because it keeps its essence well preserved until today. The National Palace of Sintra was home to the Portuguese Royal Family until 1910.

Then, you will have some fre time to explore the historical center of Sintra classified as World Heritage with its streets full of stories.

The tour continues to mainland Europe's western most point, **Cabo da Roca**. Visit Cabo da Roca (from March to October) or Boca do Inferno (from November to February), a fantastic natural cliff formation in the sea. Get to know Guincho beach, very popular with water sports fans. Discover **Cascais**, a former fishing village that became an aristocratic retreat, which stands out for its beautiful beaches, coastal life and colorful streets. On the way back to Lisbon, get to know Estoril through a panoramic view and fall in love with the breathtaking view of the Atlantic coast.
