Day **2** Zagreb Ljubljana

Day **3** Ljubljana Bled Plitvice

After having breakfast, the next stop is **Bled**, a small town in the Julian Alps that ranks among the most beautiful alpine

resorts. It's like a scene from a fairy tale, with mountains and forests surrounding an emerald glacial lake. Visit to the **Bled Castle**, which is the oldest in Slovenia.

Day **4**

Plitvice Split

This morning, explore **Plitvice Lakes National Park**, where a series of turquoise lakes are linked by waterfalls and wooden walkways. It's a place that feels both wild and serene.

Later, travel to the coastal city of **Split**. Discover the remarkable Diocletian's Palace, an ancient Roman complex that now forms the heart of the city, filled with lively squares, cafés and hidden corners.

Day **5** Split Pelješac Dubrovnik

Continue to the historic town of Ston, known for its stone walls and oyster farms, before arriving in **Dubrovnik**. A guided walk introduces you to this beautifully preserved walled city, where marble streets, baroque buildings and views over the Adriatic create a memorable setting.
