Travel north, cross through Zimbabwe and arrive at the incomparable Victoria Falls on the mighty Zambezi River.

- Tour ends at the incomparable Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

This journey begins at Rovos Rail Station in Pretoria, traveling north through Warmbaths and Nylstroom. Cross the Tropic of Capricorn and Limpopo River en route to Bulawayo, Zimbabwe. Highlights include a visit to Matobo National Park with its ancient rock art and Cecil Rhodes' grave, a game drive in Hwange National Park, and arrival at the majestic Victoria Falls. The route may include Botswana depending on railway capacity and is available in reverse.

ITINERARY

Day

1

Depart Pretoria

Depart Rovos Rail Station in Pretoria. Freshen up in your suite before relaxing in the lounge or observation car. Travel through Warmbaths, famed for its mineral waters, and Nylstroom, named for its north-flowing river. Pass the escarpment's edge as the Highveld drops dramatically. Dinner is served en route to Polokwane.

Day **2**

At Leisure onboard Rovos Rail

Enjoy breakfast as the train crosses the Tropic of Capricorn toward Louis Trichardt. After lunch, complete South African border formalities at Musina. Afternoon tea is served as the train crosses the Limpopo River heading to Beitbridge for Zimbabwean border formalities. Reflect on Kipling's tale of the Limpopo while dining en route to Gwanda.

Matobo National Park

Breakfast is served as the train journeys through baobab country to Bulawayo, Zimbabwe's second city. After lunch onboard, transfer to Matobo National Park to explore ancient bushmen caves, rock art, and Cecil John Rhodes' resting place. Return to the train at Sawmills for a formal dinner.

Hwange National Park
