### Winnipeg

## Churchill

This morning you will join a local dog musher for an exciting dog carting excursion through the boreal forest. You will be introduced to the team of sled dogs and explained the importance of dog sledding in northern culture and history. Next, pay a visit to Churchill's Itsanitaq Museum, home to one of the most extensive Inuit Art collections in the world.

In the afternoon is your first encounter with Churchill's beautiful beluga whales! You will search for beluga whales in the



Churchill River by boat and then stop for a walking tour at the historical Prince of Wales Fort where you will learn about the famous explorers who lived at the fort in the 18th century.
