This is more than a tour, it is an invitation to see Tofino through the eyes of those who have cared for these lands and seas since time immemorial.

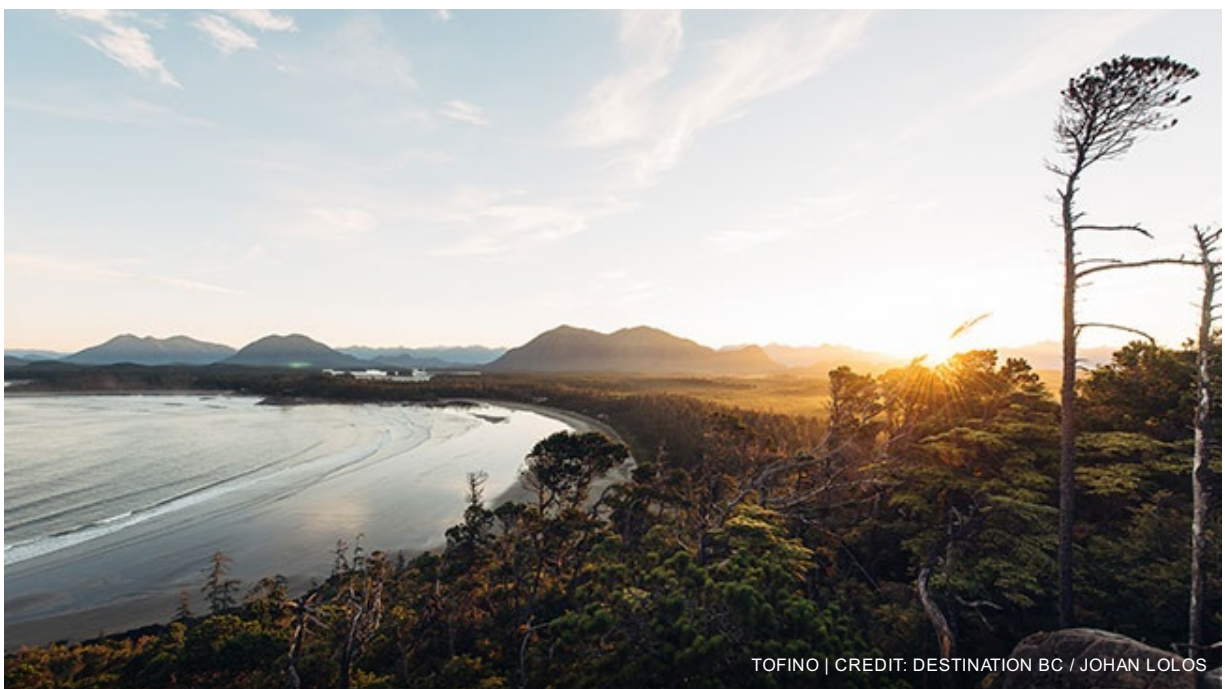
Day **2**

Embark on an Indigenous-guided whale watching tour and set out across the Pacific Ocean and Clayoquot Sound in a small vessel designed for intimate wildlife encounters. Over 2.5–3 hours, you may see grey whales, humpbacks, or even transient orcas, alongside sea otters, seals, and a variety of seabirds. Your knowledgeable Ahousaht guides will share stories passed down through generations, giving insight into the cultural and historical significance of the waters you explore, creating a truly immersive and unforgettable experience.

During your free time, perhaps go for an invigorating workout at the Tuff Fit waterfront gym, getting some exercise on high-end training equipment while enjoying a beautiful view over the water. Afterwards, perhaps refresh and recharge at Shelter Restaurant, featuring local delicacies, excellently prepared.

Day **3**

Tofino

Today, experience a Tofino bear watching excursion into the inlets of Clayoquot Sound, where you can witness these magnificent animals in their natural environment while discovering the area's rich cultural history. Along with black bears, you might encounter wildlife like sea lions, harbor seals, bald eagles, and various seabirds.

Although rarer, sightings of coastal wolves are still possible. The guides will share insights about the region's history, including the impacts of colonialism and the resilience of First Nations peoples in maintaining their cultural practices and connection to the land. You'll also explore the significance of the old-growth forests, which have been vital to the region's cultural heritage for generations.
