Thanks to its attractions, its souvenirs and watch shops, the beautiful lakeside setting and the nearby mountains Lucerne remains one of the most popular places to visit in Switzerland.

Highlights of the city include the fully restored Chapel Bridge – one of Europe's oldest wooden bridges and landmark of Lucerne.

An iconic view of the **Matterhorn** awaits, along with 29 other 4,000m peaks. There are several stops on the way which are starting points for various hiking and walking trails.

- **Matterhorn Glacier Paradise self-guided excursion:**

Visit the **Matterhorn Glacier Paradise**. One of the highest vantage points in Europe at 3,883m - right next to the Matterhorn. A series of gondolas and cable cars are taken to the summit where breathtaking views await. The Glacier Palace is a highlight where a mystical world of ice and snow showcase impressive sculptures made of ice.
