Day **1**

Toronto

Toronto

Day **3**

Toronto Niagara Falls Toronto

Day **4**

Day **6** Brockville Upper Canada Village | St. Lawrence River Cruise

Day **7** Upper Canada Village Coteau Landing | St. Lawrence River Cruise
