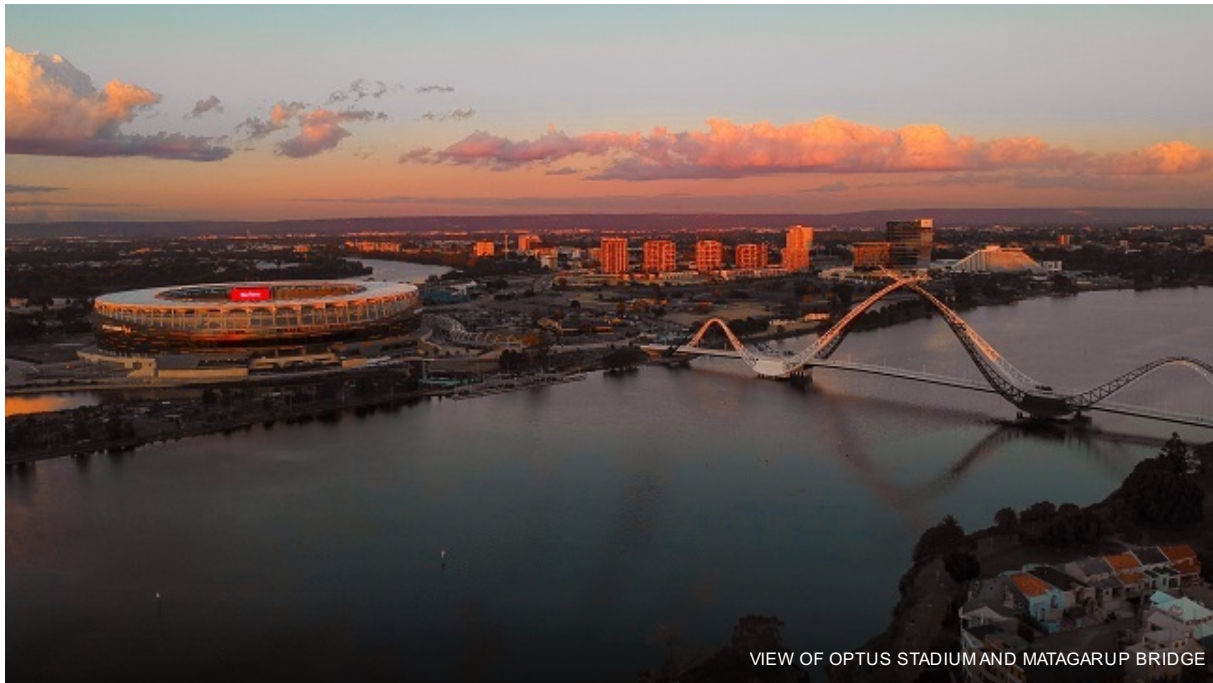


## Day at leisure
