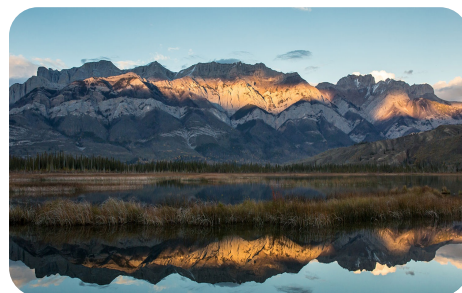

As you follow the banks of the North Thompson River through the Monashee and Cariboo mountains, you will be surrounded by breathtaking scenery as you get closer to the high peaks of the Continental Divide. Highlights include Mount Robson, the highest mountain in the Canadian Rockies at 3,954 metres, Pyramid Falls, and the journey over the Yellowhead Pass into Jasper National Park.

Day **1**

Rocky Mountaineer: Vancouver Kamloops

Board the Rocky Mountaineer train at Vancouver Station at 7:30am PT (*Pacific Time*). Travel from the coastal city of Vancouver to Kamloops, in the heart of British Columbia's interior.

On today's journey, you will see dramatic changes in scenery, from the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade Mountains, to the desert-like landscapes of the BC interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River.

Your day concludes as the Rocky Mountaineer travels along the shores of Kamloops Lake into Kamloops between 6:00pm and 7:30pm PT (*Pacific Time*). Spend the evening exploring the city of Kamloops or relaxing in your hotel room.

Day **2**

Rocky Mountaineer: Kamloops Jasper

Your journey continues north and east to the mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of Alberta. Once again, you will be surrounded by dramatic scenery as you follow the banks of the North Thompson River through the Monashee and Cariboo mountains, climbing ever nearer to the high peaks of the Continental Divide. Today's highlights include Mount Robson, at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet) the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies, Pyramid Falls, and the climb over the Yellowhead Pass into Jasper National Park. Your rail journey ends on arrival in the resort town of Jasper this evening.
