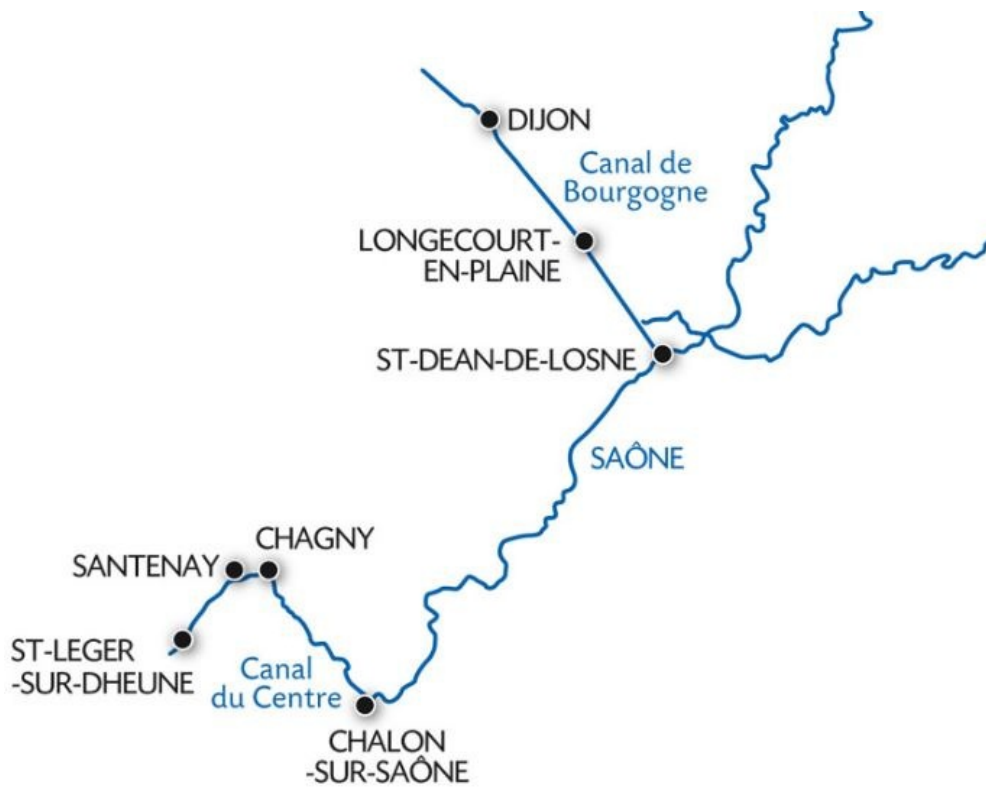
Join a unique Burgundy Canal journey from Dijon to Saint-Léger-sur-Dheune, exploring charming cities, history, wines and stunning panoramas.

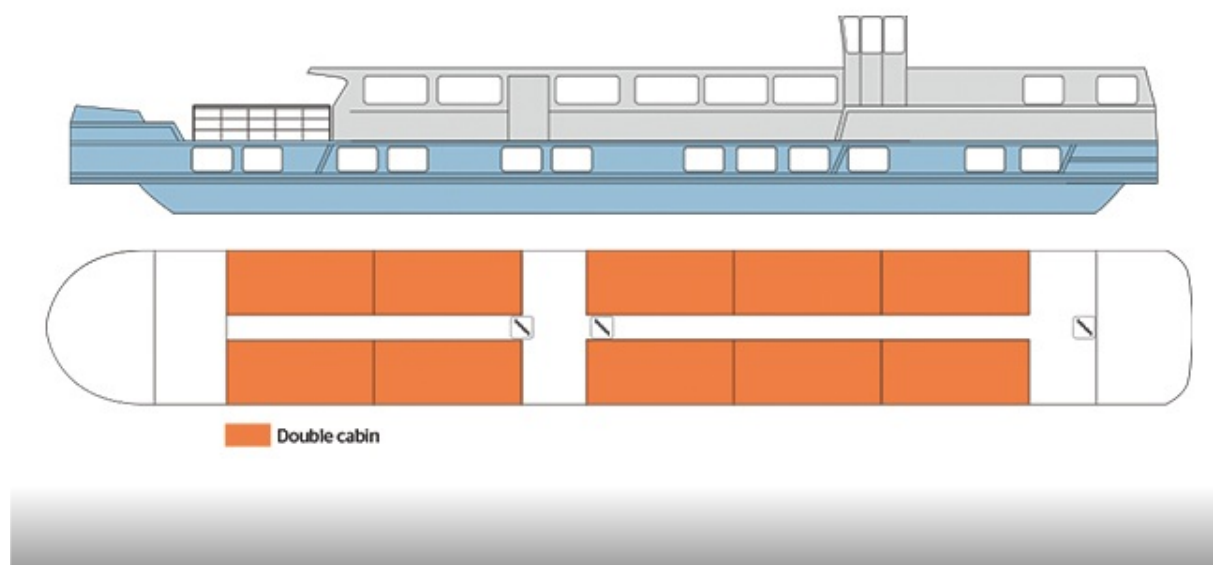
- Canal cruise, measuring 38.5m long and 5m wide

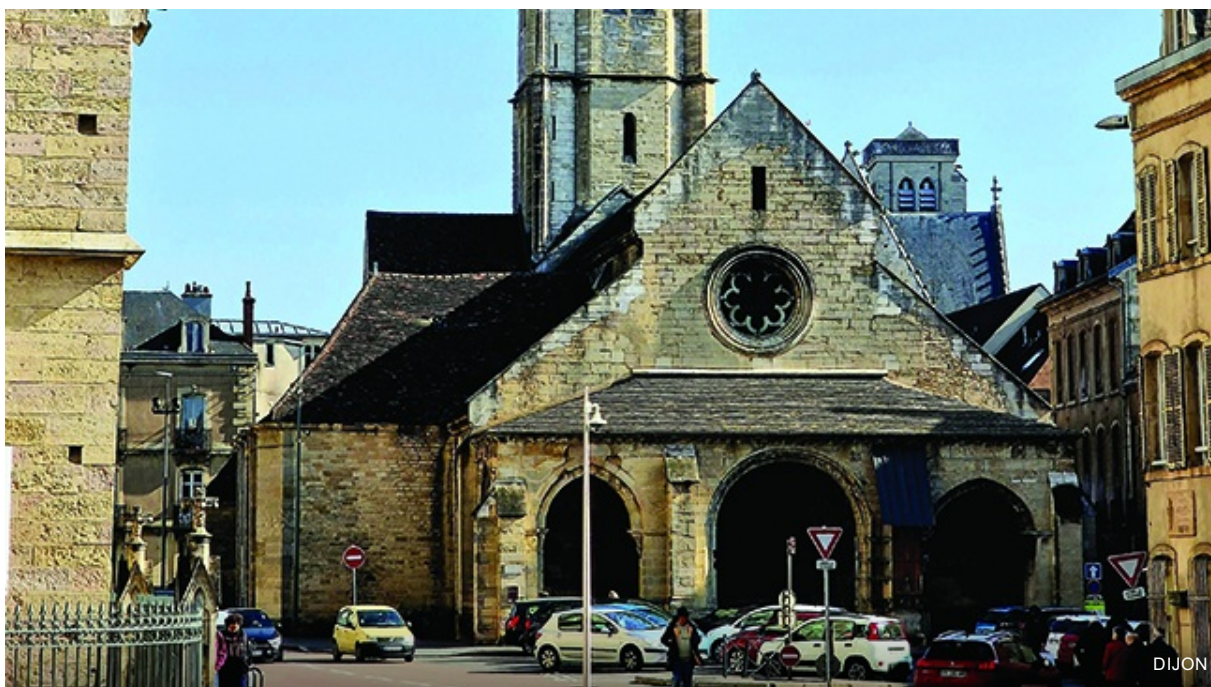


Day **1**

Dijon

Passengers may board the ship at 6:00 p.m in Dijon. After settling into your cabins, the crew will be introduced during a welcome cocktail before dinner.

Day **2**

Dijon Longecourt-en-Plaine

The morning will be spent cruising, offering a perfect opportunity to relax and take in the stunning Burgundy landscape. Alternatively, passengers can enjoy a walk or bike ride along the canal's bicycle path. In the afternoon, take part in an excursion along the Grands Crus Wine Route, which winds through picturesque villages and some of the most renowned vineyards in Burgundy. The day concludes with a return to the ship in Longecourt-en-Plaine.



Day **3** Longecourt-en-Plaine Saint-Jean-de-Losne

The morning will be spent cruising, with the option to bike along the **Doubs River** at your leisure using the Green Way bike path. In the afternoon, join a guided tour of Saint-Jean-de-Losne, where you'll explore historic monuments reflecting the city's rich past, including the monument honouring the 1636 Siege and the Hôtel-Dieu, a charitable hospital established in 1658, surrounded by beautiful 17th and 18th-century iron railings. The visit will conclude with a tasting of local Burgundy specialties.

Day **4** Saint-Jean-de-Losne Chalon-sur-Saône

The morning will be spent cruising towards **Chalon-sur-Saône**, offering beautiful views of the Saône River's hilly banks and traditional houses perched on the slopes. You are welcome to ride along the riverbank on the Green Way bike path. In the

afternoon, take part in a tour of Chalon-sur-Saône, the birthplace of Joseph Nicéphore Niépce, one of the pioneers of photography.

Day **5**

Chalon-Sur-Saone Chagny

The morning will be spent cruising towards Chagny, offering a peaceful opportunity to relax and take in the picturesque hillside views and rolling meadows along the route. Later, embark on a hike to the **Cirque du Bout du Monde**, where you'll explore the dramatic chalk cliffs shaped by the Cozanne River, forming a secluded valley. A stunning waterfall, over 80 feet tall, adds a magical touch to this remarkable natural setting.

Chagny Santenay Saint-Léger-sur-Dheune

In the morning, you'll head towards Santenay, a charming wine village rich in history and natural beauty. Once you arrive,

walk from the ship to the village center, where you can explore its quaint streets. Join in for a wine tasting at one of the 38 local producers in the area. In the afternoon, cruise towards **Saint-Léger-sur-Dheune**, offering a chance to relax and enjoy the lush landscapes. Late in the afternoon, reach Saint-Léger-sur-Dheune. The evening will culminate in a festive gala dinner.
