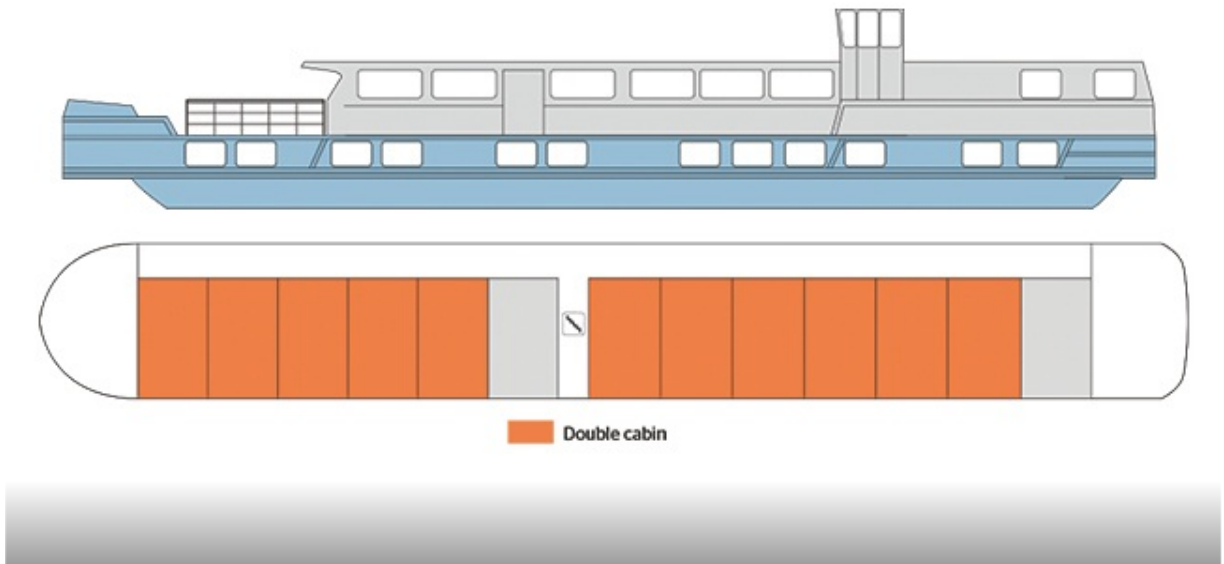
- Canal cruise, measuring 38.5m long and 5.07m wide

Strasbourg

Strasbourg Waltenheim

Waltenheim Saverne

In the afternoon, join a tour of the Château du Haut-Barr, also known as "The Eye of Alsace," where a magnificent view of the Alsatian plains awaits. In the evening, enjoy tarte flambée, a local specialty, at a restaurant.

Day **4**

Saverne Lutzelbourg

Embark on a guided tour of Saverne, a city often overlooked by typical tourist routes but offering a wealth of hidden gems to explore. Afterward, return to the vessel and cruise toward Lutzelbourg. The canal meanders through the Vosges Mountains before reaching the Lorraine region. In the late afternoon, it is suggested to take a walk to admire the stunning Lutzelbourg Castle.

Lutzelbourg Arzviller Inclined Plane Xouaxange

Visit the Lehrer Crystal Glassworks before cruising to Xouaxange. Experience the Saint-Louis-Arzviller inclined plane. Enjoy a candlelit lunch while passing through the canal tunnels. Later, explore the Chagall Trail in Sarrebourg.
