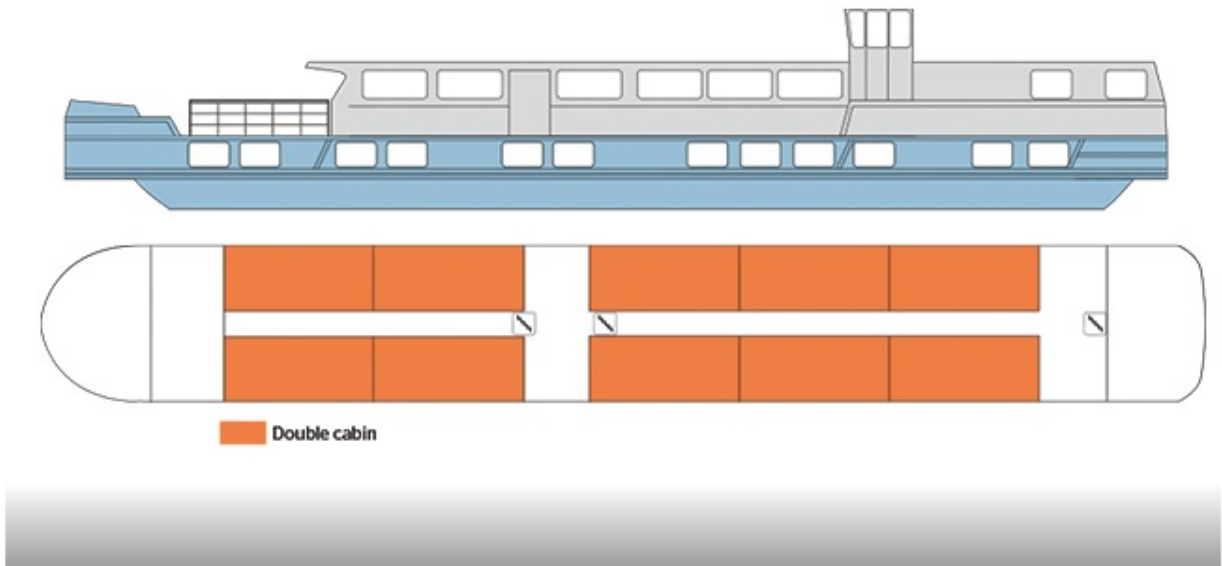
- Canal cruise, measuring 38.5m long and 5m wide

Day **1**

Ghent

Boarding begins at 6 p.m. After settling into your cabins, enjoy a welcome cocktail where the crew will be introduced.

Day **2**

Ghent Oudenaarde

This morning, take a guided tour of Bruges and a visit to a brewery. After a 60- to 75-minute coach ride from Ghent, arrive in Bruges, a city renowned for its art, peaceful atmosphere, romantic charm and stunning architecture. Its well-preserved beauty reflects the elegance of its golden age as a maritime trade hub. Following the tour, visit a brewery founded in 1856, where six generations have maintained its traditions, including the authentic Brugse Zot ale. Afterward, return to the ship in Ghent.

In the afternoon, cruise along the Scheldt River from Ghent to Oudenaarde, passing through breathtaking natural parks. Arrive in Oudenaarde by early evening and remain docked overnight.



Day

3

Oudenaarde Peronnes-lez-Antoing

This morning, take a guided tour of Oudenaarde and visit a distillery. Oudenaarde is a charming city filled with historic monuments, with the town hall and its two main churches being the most prominent. Other notable sites include the picturesque beguinage, the birthplace of Margaret of Parma, the Boudewijnstoren and the 18th-century meat market. The city boasts over 100 historic landmarks, each telling the story of its rich and vibrant past. Enjoy a guided urban hike through the city's most beautiful areas and top tourist attractions, followed by some free time to explore on your own. Next, visit a distillery to learn about the distillation of jenever, gin, and whiskey, with a tasting included.

After returning aboard, the ship will continue its journey to Péronnes-lez-Antoing. Relax on the Sun Deck and take in the passing scenery as you cruise through Tournai before arriving in Péronnes-lez-Antoing in the early evening. If you wish, enjoy an evening stroll to work off dinner. The ship will remain in port overnight.

Day

4

Peronnes-lez-Antoing Mons

The morning will be spent cruising along the Nimy-Blaton-Péronnes Canal, a key waterway in central Belgium. Opened in October 1955, the canal links the Canal du Centre with the Scheldt River. By early afternoon, we'll arrive in Mons.

A visit to the Château de Beloeil and the Chant d'Éole vineyard follows. First, explore the Château de Beloeil, often called the Belgian Versailles. This historic castle is home to a valuable collection of 15th- to 19th-century art, including a library with over 20,000 books and rare manuscripts. The furniture showcases exceptional works by French cabinetmakers from the 17th and 18th centuries, while the paintings celebrate the achievements of the castle's noble family.

Next, visit the Chant d'Éole estate, where a Belgian farming family partnered with renowned sparkling-wine makers to create the vineyard. Using modern techniques, they produce sparkling wines that honor Belgian tradition. A guided tour will take us through the vineyard's history, explaining each step of production—from planting to bottling. The tour will conclude with a tasting of three signature wines: Brut Blanc de Blancs, Rosé Brut and Elixir Saint-Georges.

Afterward, return to Mons, where the ship will remain docked overnight.

Day **5**

Mons Strépy Thieu

This morning, enjoy a food tour in Mons, a city with a rich heritage and a vibrant, modern atmosphere. The Grand-Place is filled with charming spots to explore, and your guide will take you through the heart of Mons to discover its history and culinary delights. The tour blends history, culture and local stories, with tastings of four regional specialties, making it a truly memorable experience.

Afterward, return to the ship for lunch. In the afternoon, cruise along the Canal du Centre to Strépy-Thieu. The ship will remain in port overnight.

Day **6**

Strépy Thieu Halle

Prepare for a unique experience as the barge navigates a boat lift. This lift, using two independent caissons, allows a crossing in under 35 minutes, overcoming a 240-foot height difference (75 m). It replaced four former boat lifts and two

locks. Afterward, continue the journey on the Brussels-Charleroi Canal toward Halles, where the next highlight awaits: the monumental Ronquières Inclined Plane, constructed between 1960 and 1968. This innovative engineering feat reduced delays caused by 14 previous locks. The cruise will continue on to Halle.

In the afternoon, a coach will take you to Brussels for a guided tour and a visit to a Belgian chocolate maker's workshop. Upon arrival in the Belgian capital, explore the Grand-Place, renowned for its magnificent city hall and ornate guildhalls. The City Hall, with its stunning facade and impressive tower, is one of the country's architectural treasures. Also visit the famous Manneken Pis and the Royal Saint-Hubert Galleries. Next, learn about Belgian chocolate in the heart of Brussels, discovering its history—from its Mayan origins to the artistry of modern chocolatiers—while observing a live demonstration of the chocolate-making process through windows into the workshop. Return to the ship in Halle, where the evening will conclude with a festive gala.

Halle
