On the fourth day, visit Narbonne – a lively Mediterranean city and pivotal wine-importing centre. Take time to stroll through the wonderful covered market, voted amongst the most beautiful in France. Back on board, aperitifs whet your appetite for a peaceful dinner as the sun begins its descent.

This 11th-century Cistercian monastery, now privately owned, delights with its tranquil chapter hall, refectory and well-kept rose garden. Rejoin Alouette for refreshing cocktails and a farewell gala dinner. Sit out on the balmy deck, sharing stories and highlights while indulging in exquisite seasonal delicacies.
