Day 16 Banff

Pause at the peaceful shores of Lake Minnewanka to savour a warm drink.

In the afternoon, continue your adventure to two of the most breathtaking alpine lakes in the world. Stand in awe at Lake Louise, where the turquoise waters reflect the towering peaks and the Victoria Glacier. Stroll along the lakeshore and take in the grandeur of the surrounding scenery. Then make your way to Moraine Lake, set in the stunning Valley of the Ten Peaks. A short walk up the Rockpile reveals the famous viewpoint once featured on the Canadian twenty-dollar bill, an unforgettable photo opportunity. Throughout the day, engaging stories of early explorers and mountaineers bring these landscapes to life, adding a deeper connection to the wonders around you. This full-day journey offers an unforgettable glimpse into the heart of the Rockies, blending iconic sights, natural splendour, and captivating storytelling.

Day 17 Banff Columbia Icefields Banff

Sit back and enjoy the ride along the Icefields Parkway, one of the world's most stunning scenic drives. Since you don't have to navigate or watch the road, this tour lets you to focus on the amphitheatre of mountains towering above. Keep your eyes peeled for wildlife at the edges of the forest. Dig into a hearty mountain picnic and take a photo stop at Bow Lake, one of the largest glacier-fed lakes in Banff National Park, against the backdrop of the Crowfoot Glacier. You'll also visit scenic Peyto Lake or lower Waterfowl Lake along the Icefields Parkway, a stunning glacier lake set against Mt Chephren. Climb aboard the Ice Explorer (a six-wheeled behemoth of a vehicle) and drive across the surface of this glittering sheet of ice. Walk the glass floor Glacier Skywalk, hanging from the edge of the Sunwapta Valley at 918-foot (280 m), for unparalleled views of the canyon below and mountains around you. The tour includes a picnic style lunch, Glacier Skywalk, and Ice Explorer tour.

Day 18 Banff Calgary

Enjoy a relaxed morning in Banff with time to soak up the charm of this alpine town at your own pace. Browse the boutique shops along Banff Avenue, savour a cosy breakfast in a local café, or simply take a peaceful stroll along the Bow River.

For those looking to cap off their Rocky Mountain adventure with a memorable view, a visit to the Banff Gondola is highly recommended. Ride to the summit of Sulphur Mountain, where panoramic views of six mountain ranges, the Bow Valley, and the town of Banff stretch out in every direction. At the top, explore the interactive interpretive centre, enjoy the scenic boardwalk to Sanson's Peak, and perhaps treat yourself to a light snack or coffee at the summit café with the Rockies as your backdrop.

In the early afternoon, meet your scheduled transfer for the comfortable journey from Banff to Calgary. Sit back and relax as you descend from the mountains into the rolling foothills, reflecting on the unforgettable experiences of your time in the Canadian Rockies.
