ITINERARY

31 Vancouver Revelstoke

Depart downtown Vancouver in the morning and begin your journey through the scenic Fraser Valley. Stop in Kelowna for lunch before enjoying a wine tasting at one of the Okanagan's many renowned wineries. Continue on to Craigellachie to visit the historic site of the Last Spike, a key moment in the completion of Canada's transcontinental railway. Upon arrival in Revelstoke, check in to the beautiful Sutton Place Hotel at Revelstoke Mountain Resort. Spend the evening relaxing at the hotel or take the opportunity to explore the charming and historic downtown Revelstoke.

Revelstoke Banff


