Day **2**

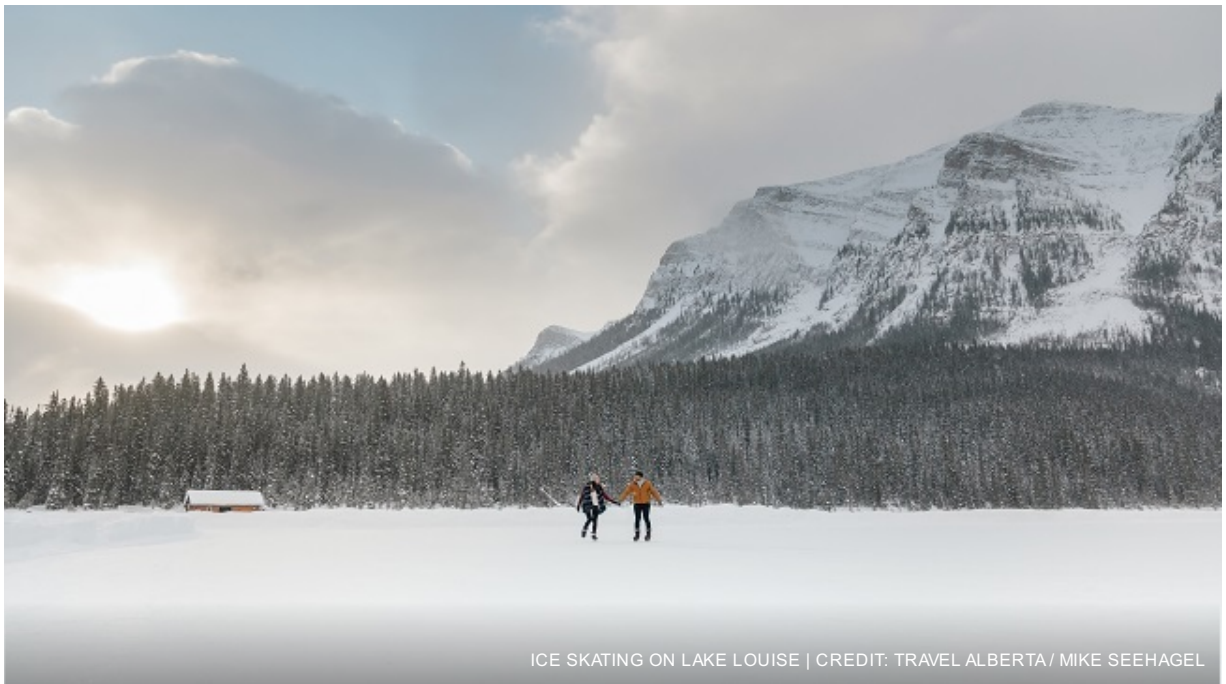
## Kamloops Banff

## Banff

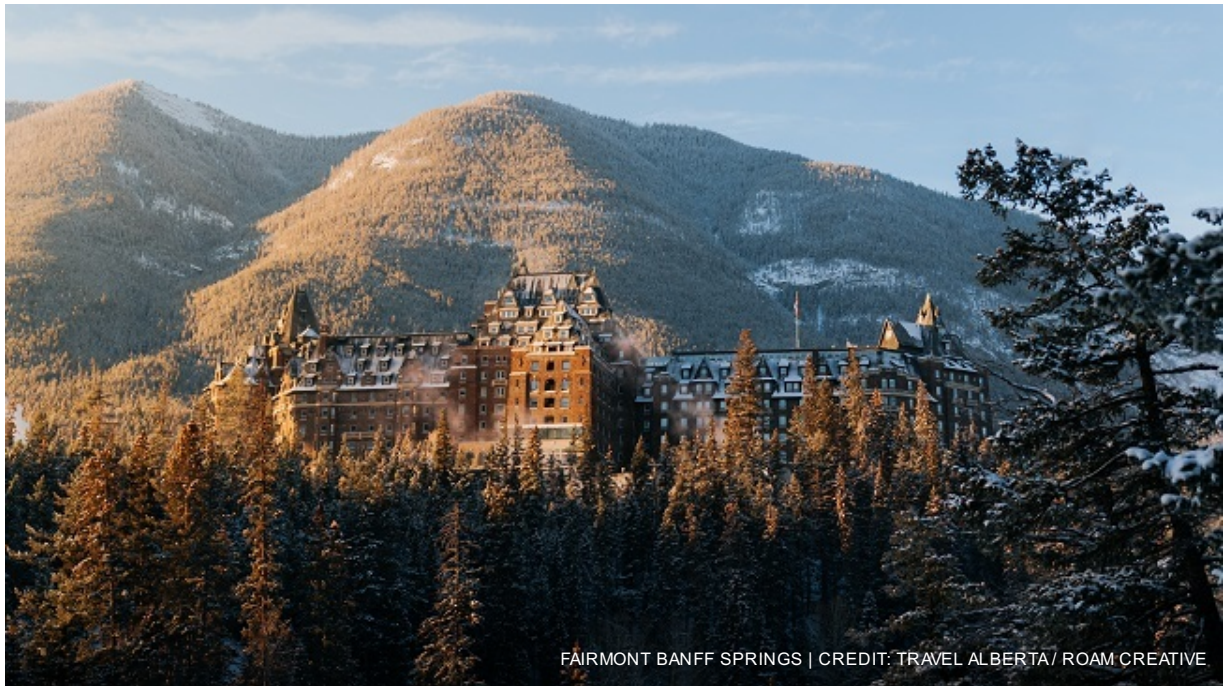
