ITINERARY

Day **1**

Montreux

Travel individually to Montreux by public transport.

Upon arrival, visit the iconic Chillon Castle, one of Europe's best-preserved medieval castles, dramatically set on a rock along the shores of Lake Geneva.

In the afternoon, enjoy an excursion to the **UNESCO-listed Lavaux vineyards**, where centuries-old wine-making traditions thrive on sun-drenched terraced hillsides. You can add an optional wine tasting (extra cost) surrounded by breathtaking views of the lake and the Alps.

Day 2 Montreux Gruyères Montreux

After breakfast, embark on a delicious journey into Switzerland's most iconic flavours. Travel from Montreux to Gruyères, where you'll visit La **Maison du Gruyère** and discover the secrets behind the country's famous cheese at a traditional show dairy. In the afternoon, satisfy your sweet tooth with a visit to *Maison Cailler*, Switzerland's oldest chocolate factory, where the rich history of Swiss chocolate comes to life.

TOWN OF GRUYÈRES

Day 3 Montreux Centovalli Railway Lugano

After two nights in the French-speaking part of Switzerland, it's time to explore the Italian-speaking region. Travel by train through the Valais to Domodossola in Italy, then board the panoramic **Centovalli Railway** to Locarno.

From there, take a short train ride to Lugano, Ticino's largest city, where you'll join a **Risotto Workshop** in a traditional Ticino grotto. A brief boat trip** across the lake brings you to Grotto San Rocco, where your host will guide you in preparing classic "Grotto Risotto," paired with local wine.

Overnight in **Lugano** in a 4* hotel.

****Please note that from September to December, the workshop is held in Lugano's city centre without the lake cruise.**

Lugano Lucerne

After breakfast, enjoy a **guided city tour of Lugano** with tasting stops featuring local specialties, including the famous white Merlot.

Following the tour, travel by train to **Lucerne** where you'll have the afternoon at leisure.

Overnight in **Lucerne** in a 4* hotel.

CHAPEL BRIDGE, LUCERNE

After breakfast, start your day with a **guided walking tour of Lucerne** to learn about the city's history and daily life.

Then, travel to the **Emmental region** to Affoltern im Emmental for the interactive "**Königsweg**" experience, where you'll see how famous Swiss Emmentaler cheese is made and have the chance to taste it.

After the tour, continue to **Bern** for your overnight stay.
