### 34 Lucerne Stanserhorn

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, board a boat to Hergiswil, then connect by train to Stans and the Stanserhorn Bahn valley station (travel by train only when boats are not in service). Ride a vintage funicular followed by the world's first opentop cable car, the **CabriO**, offering stunning panoramic views from its open-air upper deck.
