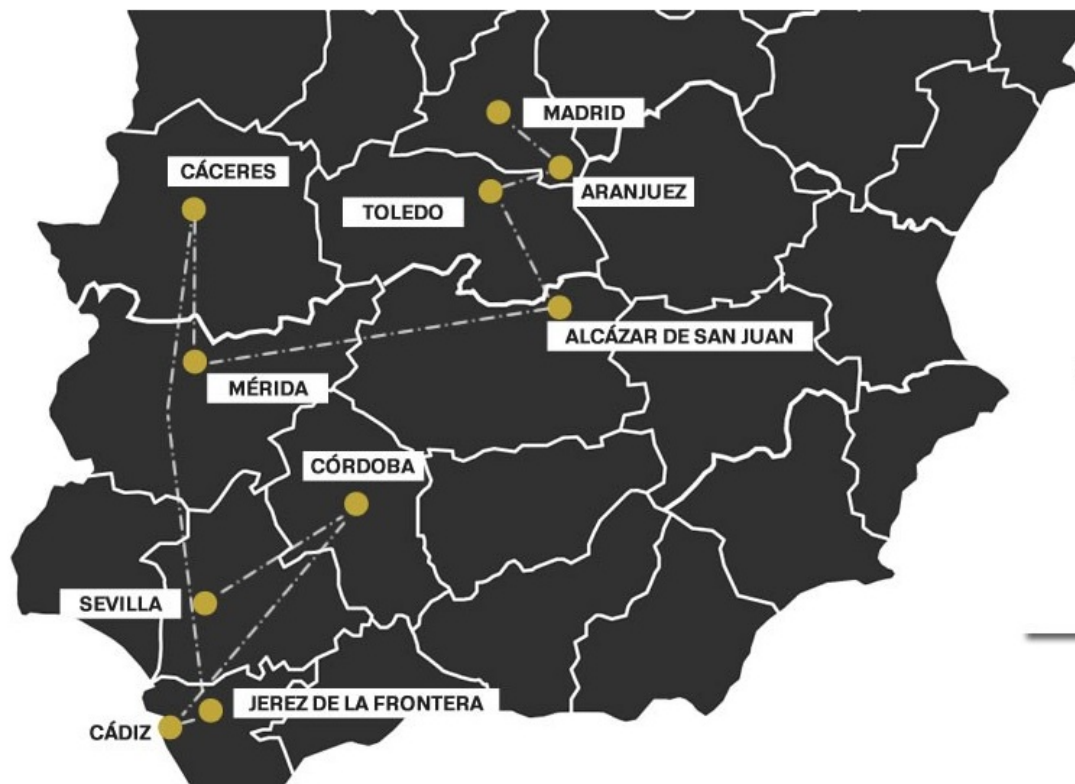

ITINERARY

Day

1

Madrid Aranjuez

Travellers are received at a designated location in Madrid at 10:00 a.m., followed by a panoramic tour of the city and lunch in the capital. In the afternoon, transfer to Aranjuez to board the Al Ándalus train. A welcome toast is offered upon arrival, followed by accommodation in private suites. The day concludes with a visit to the Royal Palace of Aranjuez and its historic gardens. Dinner is served on board. Overnight in Aranjuez.

2

Aranjuez Toledo Alcázar de San Juan

After breakfast, visit the UNESCO-listed city of Toledo, renowned for its blend of Christian, Muslim, and Jewish influences. Highlights include the Gothic cathedral, a 10th-century mosque, and two synagogues. Lunch is provided in Toledo, with free time in the afternoon. Return to the train in Aranjuez. Dinner is served on board as the train travels to Alcázar de San Juan. Overnight in Alcázar de San Juan.

Day **3** Alcázar de San Juan Cáceres

Begin the day with a visit to an artisanal cheese factory and a traditional wine cellar, highlighting two of Castilla-La Mancha's most iconic products. Lunch is served in the area. In the afternoon, explore Campo de Criptana, known for its iconic windmills featured in Cervantes' *Don Quixote*. Return to Alcázar de San Juan and board the train. Dinner is served en route to Cáceres. Overnight onboard the train in Cáceres.

Day **4** Cáceres Mérida Jerez

Enjoy breakfast on board before visiting the historic city of Cáceres, a UNESCO World Heritage Site noted for its well-preserved architecture and rich cultural heritage. Lunch is served on board as the train continues to Mérida. In the afternoon, explore Roman-era Mérida, also a World Heritage Site, known for its archaeological ruins. Dinner is served on board as the train departs for Jerez. Overnight in Jerez de la Frontera.

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day **5** Jerez de la Frontera

The day begins with breakfast, followed by a visit to the renowned equestrian show *How the Andalusian Horses Dance*, a celebrated performance set to traditional Spanish music. Lunch is served at a local restaurant, followed by a tour of a famous regional wine cellar. Dinner is served on board the train. Overnight in Jerez.

Day **6** Jerez Cádiz Córdoba

Following breakfast, depart for Cádiz, known as the "Tacita de Plata" and regarded as the oldest city in Western Europe. Return to the train for lunch on board while traveling to Córdoba. Upon arrival, visit the iconic Mosque-Cathedral and explore the city, once the capital of the Emirate and the Caliphate of Al Ándalus. Dinner is served on board. Overnight onboard the train in Córdoba.

Day **7** Córdoba Seville

Enjoy a final breakfast on board as the train arrives in Seville. The journey concludes with a guided visit to Seville, home to Spain's most extensive historic center, featuring remarkable architecture, UNESCO-listed landmarks, and picturesque gardens. The tour ends around 1:30 p.m. in Seville.

The Al Ándalus Train offers two types of accommodation:

The Grand-Class Room: A cosy room with a private bathroom. The bathroom is roomy and comfortable, featuring a shower, hairdryer, and a selection of complimentary toiletries for guests' convenience. Modern amenities such as a safe, minibar, wardrobe, luggage closet, and adjustable air-conditioning blend seamlessly with the historic train's original charm. A total of 20 Deluxe Suites are available onboard.
