Day 2-3 Zurich

After breakfast, enjoy a free day in Zurich. The Old Town with its festive light decorations will give you the perfect welcome in the winter season.

Included with your Swiss Travel Pass:

- Entry to most museums, including the National Museum
- Self-guided day trips to Rapperswil ("Town of Roses") and Rhine Falls

Day 5-6 Lucerne

After breakfast, enjoy a day at leisure in Lucerne.

Day 7 Lucerne Interlaken

Travel to Interlaken on the scenic **Lucerne–Interlaken Express**, fully included in your Swiss Travel Pass.

Nestled between Lake Thun and Lake Brienz, Interlaken is a popular Swiss resort town surrounded by the stunning peaks of the Eiger, Mönch, and Jungfrau. Known for its adventure activities, hiking trails, and breathtaking views, it is a gateway to the Bernese Oberland and offers a variety of thrilling experiences. Stroll the iconic Höheweg promenade or take a lake cruise on either Lake Thun or Lake Brienz, both covered by the Swiss Travel Pass. Thun is a beautiful city with a pedestrian old town, visit its castle for free with the Swiss Travel Pass.

Day **10** Interlaken Montreux

After breakfast, travel to Montreux on the panoramic **Golden Pass Express**, included in your Swiss Travel Pass (seat reservation included). Located on the shores of Lake Geneva, **Montreux** is known for its Riviera charm, vineyards, and cultural festivals.

Day **12-13** Zermatt

After breakfast, enjoy a full day to explore Zermatt, a car-free village known for its cosy chalets, boutique shops, and stunning views of the Matterhorn.

- Unlimited local transport (including electric buses and trains within Zermatt)

- Gornergrat Railway – panoramic ride to one of the best viewpoints of the Matterhorn and surrounding 4000m peaks
- Matterhorn Glacier Paradise – the highest cable car station in Europe, with a glacier palace, viewing platforms, and year-round snow activities
- Sunnegga–Rothorn area – ideal for skiing and family-friendly snow fun, with beautiful Matterhorn views

- In Geneva, walk through the Old Town or take a guided visit to the United Nations (supplement applies).
