### Day 1 Rome Montalcino

A dedicated Limousine Service will collect guests at the pre-arranged time from the hotel or airport, ensuring smooth and timely arrival within two hours of embarkation.

Upon arrival at the La Dolce Vita Orient Express Lounge, guests are warmly welcomed by the Guest Relations Team, available to provide assistance.

At the time of embarkation, a personal conductor escorts passengers to their private cabins. Shortly thereafter, the train departs from Rome Ostiense Station, marking the beginning of an unforgettable journey.

Lunch is served in the Restaurant Car, where a fine dining menu by Chef Heinz Beck is enjoyed alongside panoramic views of the passing landscape. The maître d' confirms individual dining times.
