Day 1

Alaska Railroad: Anchorage Seward

Board the Coastal Classic Train in the GoldStar Railcar for a breathtaking journey to Seward. This scenic trip follows the coastline of Cook Inlet and winds into the glacier-filled Chugach Mountains. On arrival in Seward, transfer by shuttle to the small boat harbour for a six-hour cruise through Kenai Fjords National Park. The park is renowned for its abundant wildlife, alpine and tidewater glaciers, and spectacular scenery. As you cruise through Resurrection Bay, keep an eye out for Steller sea lions, seals, puffins, eagles and whales. Cruise past the Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge, home to a wide variety of birdlife, on your way to either Holgate or Aialik Glacier. You'll stop in front of the glacier to hear it moving and may even witness ice calving into the ocean. Lunch is included onboard.

Freedom of Choice Options

- **Tonsina Point Resurrection Bay Kayaking Adventure:**

Resurrection Bay is surrounded by snow-capped mountains and home to several Alaska state parks that offer abundant opportunities to hike, sea kayak and explore!

OR

- **Bear Lake Kayak | Canoe Trip:**

Kayak or canoe on this scenic local lake with fun-loving guides. Bear Lake is located just outside Seward, Alaska and normally offers flat calm waters, and a home for Sockeye salmon. On the way there is a stop to visit the salmon weir and learn about their life cycle. Eagles, loons, and bears are often seen while on this adventure.

OR

- **Wilderness Dog Sled Ride Tour:**

Visit the Seavey Family Homestead in Seward, and tour the beautiful tether free summer camp for Iditarod athletes! Meet the dogs, feel their excitement as teams are hitched to comfortable summer sleds, then mush for two miles through the scenic rainforest.

OR

- **Resurrection Bay Wildlife Tour:**

Admire the icy blue waters of Resurrection Bay as your boat glides past glaciers, snowcapped mountains, and dramatic cliffs. On this 5-hour Kenai Fjords cruise, watch for whales, puffins, and otters with a wildlife guide. Visit Fox Island for a delicious lunch at a private lodge and enjoy skipping stones at a pebble beach. Learn about the area's natural history during this unforgettable Resurrection Bay adventure.

OR

- **Exit Glacier Hike:**

This moderate hiking adventure is great for viewing the jewel of the Resurrection River Valley - Exit Glacier. This massive wall of blue ice descends the mountainside from the Harding Ice Field, down to the Resurrection River.

Day 3

Seward Whittier Alaska Railroad: Anchorage

This morning, set off on a private transfer to Whittier. Along the way, experience the famous Anton Anderson Memorial Tunnel, the longest one-lane highway tunnel in North America, shared with the Alaska Railroad. In Whittier, board the 26 Glaciers Cruise and journey deep into Prince William Sound, where you'll see 26 named glaciers and many more unnamed. Get up close to these towering masses of ice, so near you can hear the glaciers move and admire their brilliant blue hues. Lunch is included onboard. Back in Whittier, board the Alaska Railroad's Glacier Discovery train for the final leg of the journey to Anchorage.

- **Turnagain Arm Wildlife Tour with Alyeska Tram:**

This full day tour from Anchorage includes an aerial tram ride up Mt. Alyeska, fresh lunch in Girdwood and tour of the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Centre home to moose, brown and black bears, wolves, bald eagles, musk oxen, and reindeer, giving guests an opportunity to view each species up close.

OR

- **Hatcher Pass Hike and History Tour:**

This half-day afternoon excursion from Anchorage includes a local guide, a tour at Independence Mine State Historical Park, gold panning and an interpretive hike along the Mill Loop Trail (an easy .9-mile trail with 177-feet of elevation gain). Travel along the Knik Arm, ascend into the Talkeetna Mountains and witness the breathtaking alpine area known as Hatcher Pass.

OR

- **Anchorage Flightseeing Safari:**

View Alaska's largest city from above! On this 30-minute introductory flight, you'll launch from Lake Hood and fly to some of the most scenic sites in the area. Options include the stunning backdrop of Anchorage, the Chugach Mountain Range, Turnagain Arm or the Cook Inlet – all with great opportunities to spot wildlife from the air. Please note that wheeled planes may be used early and late season.

OR

- **Sunset Photo Safari:**

Chase the best light of the day, which during summer in Alaska can last for several glorious hours before sunset. You'll be transported to scenic locations around Anchorage and Chugach State Park to shoot a variety of enchanting subjects. The itinerary is flexible and allows for spontaneous stops to photograph wildlife en route. Along the way, you'll be offered creative and technical support from your Alaska Photo Treks guide.

OR

- **Anchorage Scenic City Tour:**

Embark on a historical tour starting in downtown Anchorage, where you'll explore the origins of the city at Ship Creek. Witness Chinook salmon in the world's only urban King salmon fishery. Discover Dena'ina heritage, visit Earthquake Park, and experience the world's busiest seaplane base at Lake Hood. Conclude with panoramic views from Anchorage's Hillside, where wildlife sightings, including moose and eagles, are possible.

OR

- **Anchorage Walking Tour - Downtown Food & History:**

Stroll downtown Anchorage on a three-hour guided food and history adventure. Sample regional specialties—fresh seafood, gourmet reindeer sausage, handmade desserts—while hearing fascinating tales of Alaska's past from engaging local guides. Perfect for foodies and culture lovers alike.

- **Denali Highway Jeep Excursion | Self-Drive Guided 4x4 Excursion:**

Ranked #2 in Drives of a Lifetime by National Geographic Traveler magazine, experience the natural wonders of Alaska's Denali Highway — this time by Jeep! This 4-hour guided excursion travels along a 135 mi (217 km) gravel road & takes you off the beaten path in a 4 x 4 to enjoy scenic views of Denali, the Alaska Range, glaciers and wildlife.

OR

- **Tundra Wilderness Tour | Coach Tour:**

This half day tour offers incredible scenery, a narrated history of the park road and opportunities to view the park's wildlife inhabitants. Picturesque highlights include the craggy cliffside of Cathedral Mountain, wildlife rich Sable Pass and braided wash of the East Fork River in Denali National Park.

By early afternoon, board the Alaska Railroad's Denali Star in the GoldStar Railcar for the journey to Fairbanks. Relax and enjoy the late-afternoon scenery as you travel north, where your incredible Alaskan adventure comes to an end.
