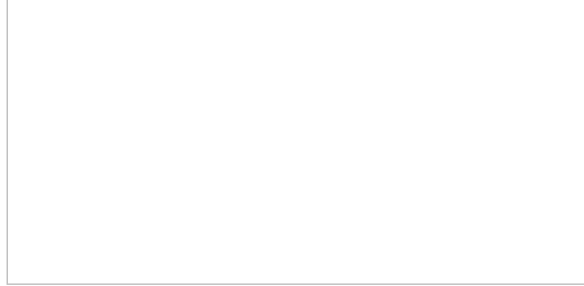
Swimming
