ITINERARY

Day 1

Arrive in Johannesburg

On arrival at O.R. Tambo International Airport (JNB), an English-speaking Guest Service Officer will meet you holding a board with your name. After collecting your luggage, you will be assisted and guided to your onward service.

Enjoy a complimentary scheduled shuttle transfer (seat-in-shared vehicle) with an English-speaking driver to the **Southern Sun O.R. Tambo International Airport Hotel**.

The shuttle operates every 15 minutes, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The pick-up point is located behind the InterContinental Hotel at the bus/shuttle terminal.

Overnight in Johannesburg at **Southern Sun O.R Tambo International Airport Hotel**.



Day 2

Johannesburg Mpumalanga (Gateway to the Kruger National Park)

Begin the day with a complimentary scheduled shuttle transfer (seat-in-coach) from **Southern Sun O.R. Tambo International Airport Hotel** to **O.R. Tambo International Airport**. The shuttle operates every 15 minutes, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, with pick-up at the bus/shuttle terminal behind the InterContinental Hotel.

Fly from Johannesburg to Nelspruit (Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport). On arrival, enjoy a private transfer to **Mdluli Safari Lodge***, located inside the south-western region of the Kruger National Park – one of South Africa's most iconic safari destinations and home to the Big Five.

Settle into luxury tented accommodation featuring private patios, indoor and outdoor showers, and uninterrupted views over the park.

Overnight stay at **Mdluli Safari Lodge**.

Return to Johannesburg

From the airport, travel by private sedan transfer to **54 on Bath Hotel**, a stylish retreat in the heart of Johannesburg. Known for its striking red-brick facade and elegant interiors, this award-winning hotel blends modern design with classic sophistication. 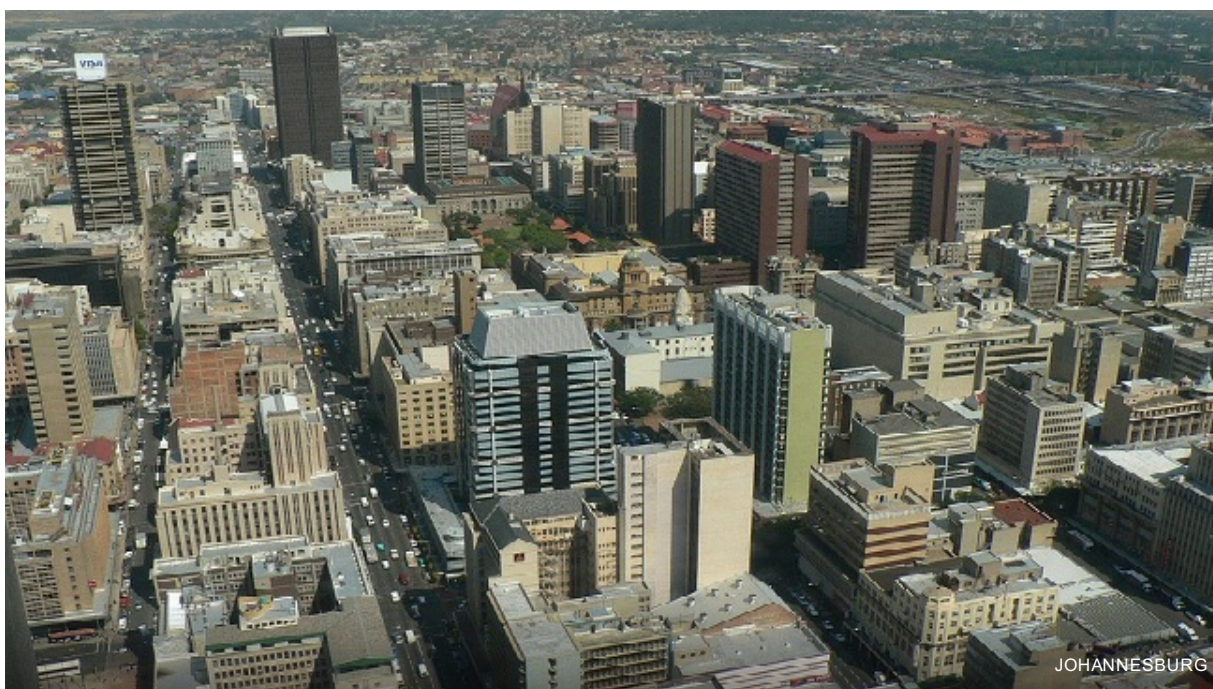

Rovos Rail: Depart Pretoria

Begin the day with a seamless private transfer by standard sedan, accompanied by an English-speaking driver, from **54 on Bath Hotel** to Capital Park Railway Station, the departure point for the Rovos Rail journey.

Board the train in Pretoria and settle into a luxurious suite before relaxing in the lounge or observation car. Travel through Warmbaths, known for its mineral springs, and Nylstroom, named for its north-flowing river. Continue past the dramatic edge of the escarpment as the Highveld drops away. Dinner is served on board en route to Polokwane.

Afternoon tea is served as the train crosses the Limpopo River heading to Beitbridge for Zimbabwean border formalities. Reflect on Kipling's tale of the Limpopo while dining enroute to Gwanda.

Day 11 Rovos Rail: Victoria Falls

Ensure luggage is packed and ready 15 minutes before departure, with passports at hand. Breakfast is served on board until 09:30am, enjoyed from the observation car at the front of the train – a rare treat for rail enthusiasts.

The journey concludes with arrival at the spectacular **Victoria Falls**, Zimbabwe, one of the world's most awe-inspiring natural wonders.

Zimbabwe is renowned for its dramatic landscapes, exceptional safaris and rich wildlife. Home to national parks teeming with hippos, rhinos and an extraordinary variety of birdlife, it is a paradise for nature lovers.

The country's crown jewel, **Victoria Falls** – known locally as "The Smoke That Thunders" – plunges 108 metres into Batoka Gorge, creating one of the most breathtaking sights in Africa. Visitors can enjoy a range of activities, from white-water rafting and river cruises to bungee jumping, scenic picnics and birdwatching.

On arrival, a **private transfer** is waiting (5-seater vehicle with English-speaking driver) from **Victoria Falls Railway Station** to **Insika Lodge** for a **3-night stay**, perfectly positioned to explore this iconic destination.

Day 12 Victoria Falls

Stroll through the lush, mist-covered rainforest that borders the Falls and stop at famous vantage points including the **Main Falls**, **Horseshoe Falls**, **Rainbow Falls**, the **Boiling Pot**, **Cataract Island**, and **Livingstone Island**. Hear the thunderous roar, feel the cool spray on your skin, and witness millions of litres of water plunging into the dramatic gorges below. This unforgettable experience captures the sheer scale and beauty of one of the planet's most awe-inspiring natural spectacles.
