## Rocky Mountaineer: Jasper Kamloops

Departing early in the morning, travel onboard the Rocky Mountaineer from Jasper in the Canadian Rockies to Kamloops, in the heart of the British Columbia Interior. As you journey west and south, you will be surrounded by the dramatic scenery of the Continental Divide and the river valleys of the Monashee and Cariboo Mountains. Today's highlights include the climb over the Yellowhead Pass, Pyramid Falls, and Mount Robson, at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet), the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies, as well as the journey along the North Thompson River as you approach Kamloops in the evening.

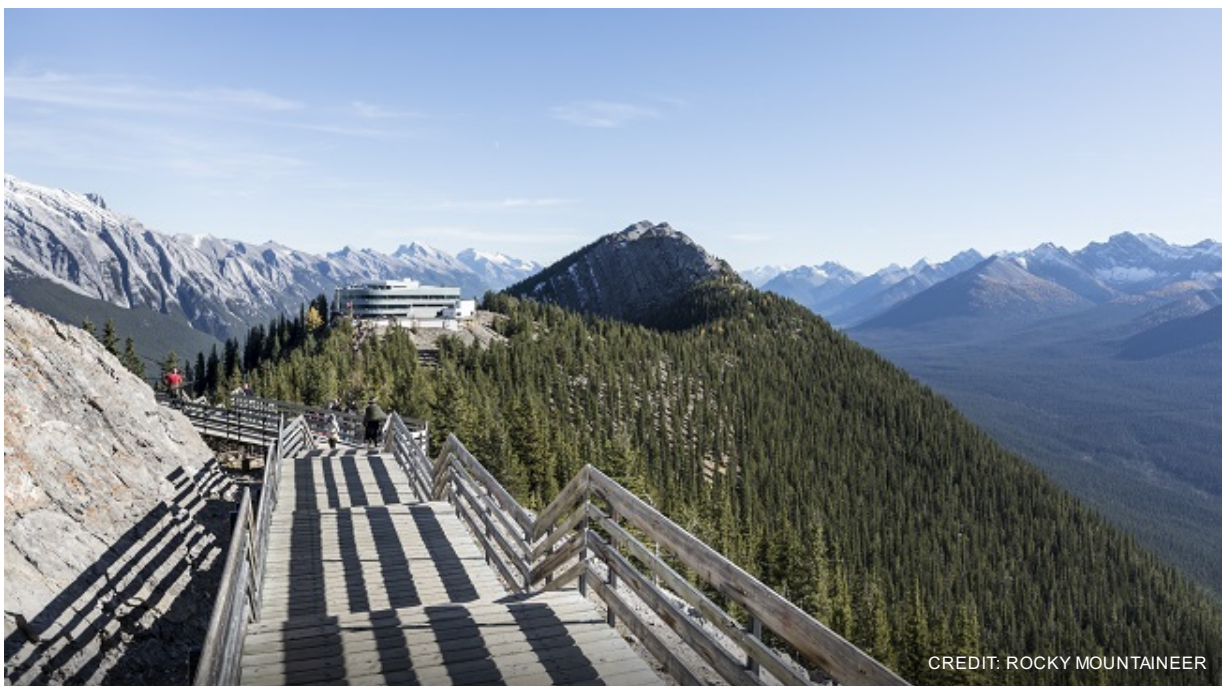

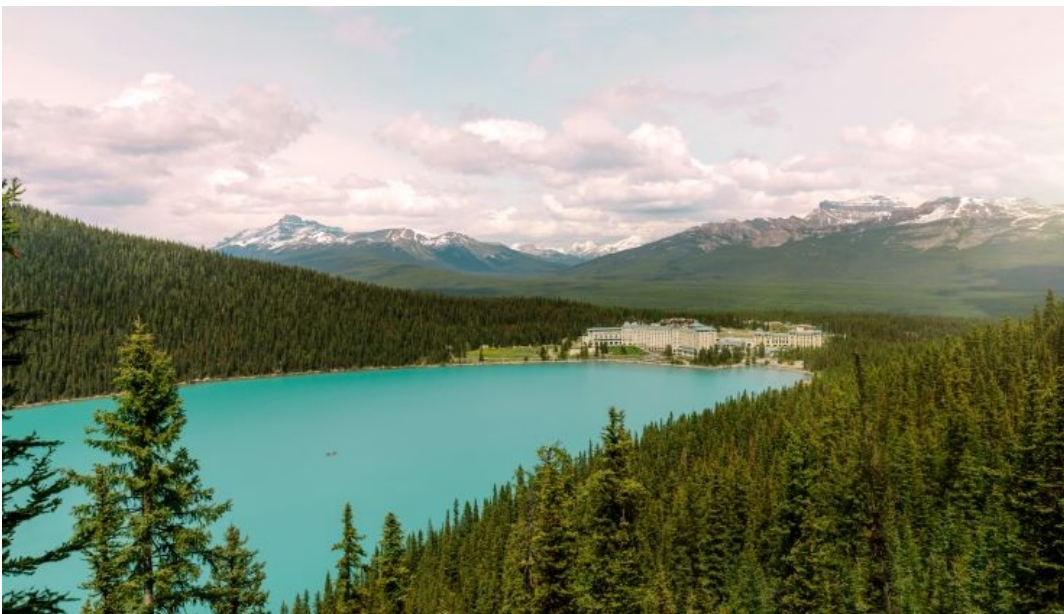
