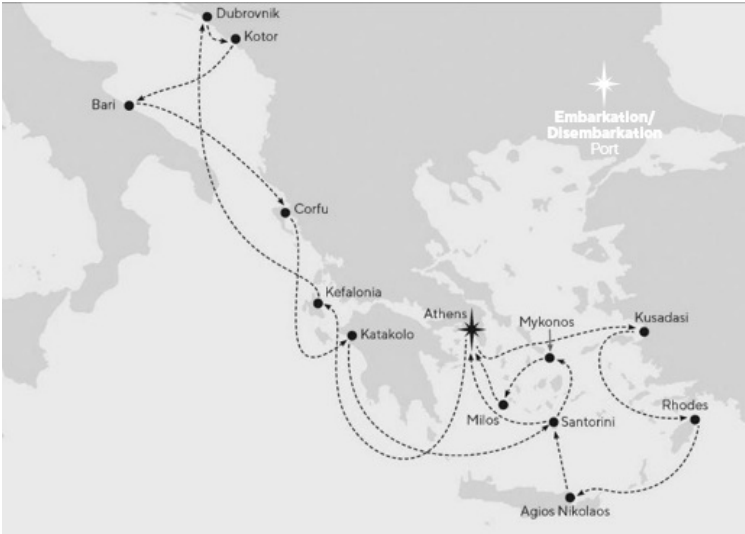

ITINERARY

Day 1	Athens Airport Athens Welcome to Athens the birthplace of Western Civilization, the Capital of Greece! Upon arrival at Athens International Airport meet with your English-speaking escort and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Athens at NJV Athens Plaza Hotel or similar.
Day 2	Athens After breakfast, enjoy a Half Day Tour including Athens sightseeing, Acropolis site & Acropolis Museum. Drive past key city landmarks such as the Temple of Zeus, the Old Stadium, Syntagma Square, the Parliament, the Tomb of

the Unknown Soldier, the Academy, the National Library, and the National Gardens.

On the Acropolis, admire the Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion with its Caryatids, and the iconic Parthenon. Nearby, the Acropolis Museum—designed with modern materials and bioclimatic features—offers a striking view of the Acropolis and a world-class display of ancient treasures.
