Continue through the scenic Borgarfjörður region and the spellbinding Snæfellsnes Peninsula, before ending your journey with a tranquil soak in the geothermal waters of Hvammsvík Hot Springs.

ITINERARY

Reykjavik

Upon arrival, pick up your rental vehicle at Keflavík Airport.

Drive to your hotel in Reykjavik. Check in and the rest of the day is at leisure.

Overnight stay in Reykjavik at Sand Hotel by Keahotels or similar.



Reykjavik South Coast Skaftafell

After breakfast at your hotel, set out on the **Viking Trail** from Reykjavik through **Selfoss** and **Hvolsvöllur**, where farmland gives way to glaciers and volcanoes. Stop at the stunning **Seljalandsfoss** and hidden **Gljúfrabúi** waterfalls before visiting the mighty **Skógafoss**.

Continue to the coastal village of **Vík í Mýrdal** for sweeping views from the church before exploring the dramatic black sand beach of **Reynisfjara**. On your return journey, stop at **Sólheimajökull** glacier before heading back to **Reykjavik** — a day

filled with Iceland's most breathtaking natural wonders.

Overnight stay in Öræfi at Fosshotel Glacier Lagoon or similar.

3 Skaftafell

After breakfast, drive down to Skaftafell.

This breathtaking glacier hike from Skaftafell will take you to a great moving glacier in Vatnajökull National Park.

Glacier Wonders is a superb glacier hiking tour from Skaftafell into the magnificent ice world of **Falljökull glacier**, a tongue of the mighty Vatnajökull, the largest glacier in Europe. Your certified glacier guide will show you astonishing crevasses which wind through the ice and incredible glistening ice formations. During this tour, you will learn how a living glacier moves and why this magical ice kingdom is constantly changing.

Overnight stay in Öræfi at Fosshotel Glacier Lagoon or similar.

§ 4 Skaftafell Golden Circle Selfoss

After breakfast, set off on a self-drive Golden Circle Tour.

Visit the unmissable **Thingvellir National Park**, **Gullfoss Waterfall**, and **Geysir Hot Springs**. We'll also stop at off-the-beaten-track spots like **Faxi Waterfall** and **Hveragerði**, a geothermal town in Southwest Iceland. In just one day you'll get a real feel for the Land of Fire and Ice.


