Day 1	<div><div>Belfast</div><div><p>Welcome to Belfast!</p><p>Upon arrival at the airport, you will be met by your driver and transferred by private vehicle to your hotel in Belfast, where you will be assisted with check-in.</p><p>Overnight stay in Belfast at Ramada by Wyndham Belfast or similar.</p></div></div>
Day 2	<div><div>Belfast</div><div><p>Begin your visit at Titanic Belfast museum by exploring nine interactive galleries that trace the ship’s story from its design and construction to its tragic sinking and legacy. Experience the Shipyard Ride, step onto the historic slipways, and marvel at recreated interiors like the grand staircase. Discover personal stories from passengers and crew, then learn about the wreck’s discovery in Titanic Beneath. Your ticket also includes access to SS Nomadic, the last remaining White Star Line vessel, offering a unique glimpse into maritime history. Allow two to three hours to immerse yourself in this world-class attraction that brings Titanic’s tale to life.</p><p>Overnight stay in Belfast at Ramada by Wyndham Belfast or similar.</p><p>Breakfast</p></div></div>
Day 3	<div><div>Belfast Giant’s Causeway Belfast</div><div><p>After breakfast, you will enjoy a shared day Tour to Giant Causeway.</p><p>Departing from central Belfast (approx. 9 am). Enjoy a scenic journey along the breathtaking Antrim Coast Road, passing charming villages, coastal cliffs, and lush valleys. Your first stop is the imposing Carrickfergus Castle, a splendid Norman fortress offering panoramic views. Continue with photo stops at the iconic Dark Hedges (Game of Thrones backdrop) and the port viewpoint overlooking the famed Carrick-a-Rede Rope Bridge. Arrive at the Giant’s Causeway, where you’ll have about 1.5–2 hours to wander among the 40,000 basalt hexagonal columns and explore the visitor centre. On the return leg, relax as you head back to Belfast, arriving around 5–5:30 pm.</p><p>Overnight stay in Belfast at Ramada by Wyndham Belfast or similar.</p><p>Breakfast, Dinner</p></div></div>
