From the Chianti wine region to Siena, Pienza, Bagno Vignoni, Perugia and Assisi, explore UNESCO treasures, evocative contrade, and serene piazzas. Savour hands-on cooking, artisan traditions, and curated wine tastings, alongside visits to abbeys and hilltop hamlets. With ample leisure time to wander cobbled lanes and panoramic roads, this itinerary blends culture, gastronomy and breathtaking landscapes for an immersive and unhurried Italian escape.

Day 1

Florence Colle di Val d'Elsa

Upon arrival at Florence airport, pick up your rental car and drive to your accommodation in the Chianti Wine Region. Take the rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight stay in Colle di Val d'Elsa at **Palazzo San Lorenzo Hotel & Spa** or similar.

Day 2

Colle di Val d'Elsa San Gimignano Colle di Val d'Elsa

In the morning, reach the walled hilltop gem of **San Gimignano**, a UNESCO World Heritage site famed for its skyline of 14 medieval towers. Stroll through its remarkably preserved historic center, where cobblestone alleys, Romanesque and Gothic architecture, and artisan shops evoke the charm of Tuscany's medieval past.

Lunch at leisure and rest of the day free.

Overnight stay in Colle di Val d'Elsa at **Palazzo San Lorenzo Hotel & Spa** or similar.

Day 3

Colle di Val d'Elsa

In the morning, enjoy a hands-on cooking class at a traditional Tuscan farm, where you'll learn to prepare regional recipes

using fresh, local ingredients. Then sit down to savour your creations over a **relaxed lunch and wine tasting**, surrounded by the charm of the countryside.

Day 4

Colle di Val d'Elsa Siena

Breakfast and check out. Drive to your next accommodation near **Siena** and leave your luggage at the hotel.

Explore one of Siena's historic contrade—the city's ancient districts that form the beating heart of its social and cultural identity. Each contrada is a close-knit community with its own emblem, museum, and centuries-old traditions tied to the famed Palio horse race.

On this immersive walk, you'll discover quiet but significant corners, where the spirit of the neighbourhood endures through rituals, oral history, and strong local pride. Surrounded by timeless charm, experience the slower rhythm that reveals Siena's most authentic soul.

Lunch at leisure and rest of the day free.

Overnight stay in Siena at **Hotel NH Siena** or similar.

Day 5

Siena

In the morning, experience the prestige of **Castello di Brolio**, an icon of Chianti Classico and the cradle of Ricasoli winemaking. Enjoy privileged access to the castle's private gardens, chapel, and family collection before continuing to the state-of-the-art winery for a curated tasting of three refined labels. A sophisticated immersion into one of Tuscany's most historic and influential estates.

Take the afternoon at leisure to discover on your own pace the local villages such as Radda in Chianti and Gaiole in Chianti.

Day **7**

Siena Bagno Vignoni

Check out and private transfer to your next accommodation. Drop off your luggage and reach Pienza.

Set out on a **walking tour to discover the “perfect city”** - an architectural gem worth the UNESCO site designation. Step into the stunning Palazzo Piccolomini, its Renaissance style hanging garden and the breathtaking view of the Val d'Orcia. Reach Rocca d'Orcia, a tiny hilltop medieval village dominated by the ruins of the Medieval Tower of Tentennano. Then enjoy a delightful lunch (reservation included - lunch à la carte to be paid on spot).

Finally, drive along winding country roads studded with vineyards, olive groves, green hills, and reach the Romanesque Abbey of Sant'Antimo, a beautiful and evocative Benedictine Monastery dating back to the 8th century.

Return to your accommodation for the check in and rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight stay in Castiglione d'Orcia at **Relais Osteria dell'Orcia** or similar.

Your private tour guides you through the vineyards, winery, and barrel cellar, ending with a terrace tasting of three wines and extra-virgin olive oil — an authentic and refined experience.

Continue to your accommodation in Perugia and rest of the day at leisure.

In the morning, enjoy a **walking tour of Perugia and visit Moretti-Caselli Studio and Museum**. Nestled in the historic centre of Perugia, the Moretti-Caselli Studio and Museum is a living testament to five generations of master glass painters. Housed in a 15th-century building that has preserved its original layout and period frescoes, the site invites visitors into an extraordinary world where artistry, history, and science meet.
