Day 1 Florence Monteriggioni

Upon arrival at Florence airport, pick-up your rental car and drive to your accommodation in the Tuscan countryside.

Monteriggioni

In the morning, **reconnect with nature on a scenic hike through the rolling hills of Val d'Elsa, led by an expert environmental guide**. Discover the local flora and fauna, from wild herbs to native animal species, while learning about the delicate balance of this unique ecosystem. Breathe in the peace of the Tuscan countryside and awaken your senses in the heart of nature. The experience culminates in a homemade lunch at a local family-run farmhouse for a true taste of Tuscany.

Monte Argentario Rome

After breakfast and check out, set off to explore the **Orbetello Lagoon**, a protected wetland managed with the support of WWF and considered one of Tuscany's richest environments for biodiversity. During your guided experience, you may spot pink flamingos, herons, ospreys, ducks, and other species thriving undisturbed in this natural oasis.

After some time for lunch at leisure, continue to **Rome** and drop off your car. Then, private transfer to your accommodation in the city centre and rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight stay in Rome at **Hotel L'Orologio Roma** or similar.

In the morning, enjoy a relaxing **guided nature walk through the enchanting Appian Way Regional Park**, where ancient Roman ruins blend harmoniously with serene countryside landscapes. Learn about the area's history, wildlife, and flora while taking in the peaceful atmosphere.

It's a fascinating experience that will take you to the heart of a grand Domus of ancient Rome, allowing you to discover every detail of this lost world.

Return to the hotel and have lunch at leisure. Rest of the day free.
