Day 1 Xi'an

After lunch at a local restaurant, the highlight of your day unfolds with a visit to the world-renowned Terracotta Warriors. Discovered by farmers in 1974, this vast subterranean army—over 6,000 intricately detailed life-sized soldiers, horses, and chariots—was created to protect China's first emperor, Qin Shi Huang, in the afterlife. Wander through the vast excavation pits and marvel at the individuality of each warrior, from the folds of their armour to the expressions on their faces. This extraordinary archaeological site is a powerful testament to the ambition, artistry, and military might of ancient China and is widely regarded as one of the greatest discoveries of the 20th century.

After a day filled with awe and inspiration, return to the comfort of the Golden Eagle Silk Road Express for a grand Welcome Dinner onboard.




Luoyang
