Flinders Ranges

After a day of exploration, return to The Ghan and relax as the train continues north, reflecting on a day immersed in the landscapes and history of the outback.

You can also visit the striking Simpsons Gap or upgrade to a scenic helicopter flight and witness the sheer scale of this remarkable region.
