Day **1**

Vienna

Vienna Ljubljana

Overnight stay in Ljubljana at **Grand Plaza Hotel & Congress Center** or similar.

Day 5 Ljubljana Zadar Split

Depart Slovenia and travel into Croatia. Stop in the historic coastal city of Zadar to visit its Roman Forum and the Church of St. Donatus before continuing along the Adriatic Coast to Split.

Day 6 Split

Discover Split during a guided city tour. Explore Diocletian's Palace, the Peristyle Square, the Cathedral of St. Domnius, the Temple of Jupiter and the lively waterfront promenade. The remainder of the day is at leisure.

Day 7 Split Dubrovnik

Travel along the spectacular Dalmatian Coast towards Dubrovnik while enjoying magnificent Adriatic scenery. Upon arrival, explore the UNESCO World Heritage Old Town, including the Franciscan Monastery, Rector's Palace, Cathedral and the

impressive city walls.

Travel to Zagreb, the capital of Croatia. Enjoy a guided tour through the historic Upper Town, including St. Mark's Church, the Cathedral and the Government Palace.

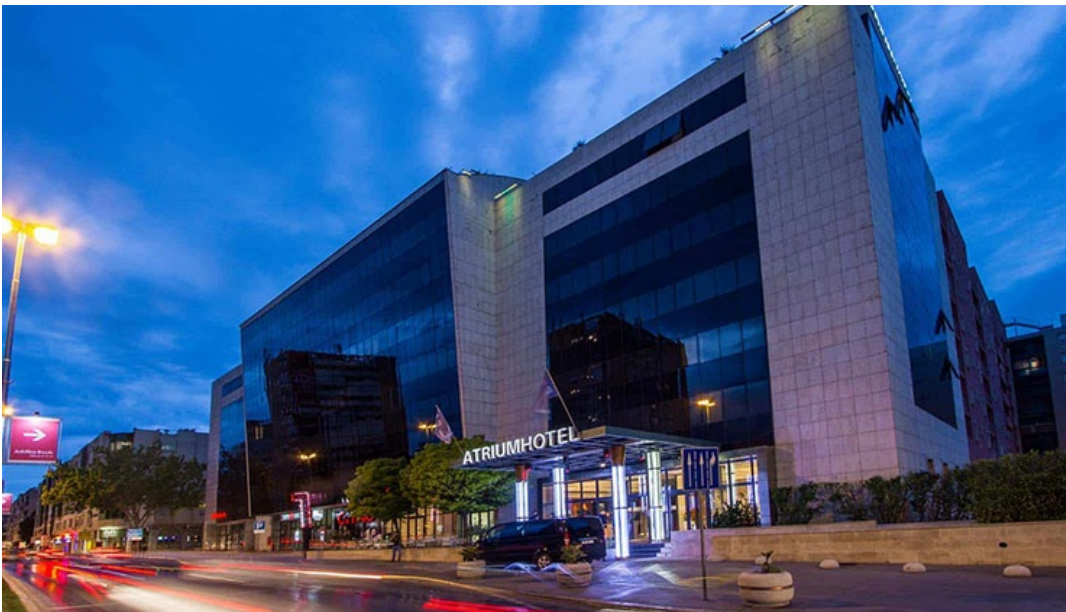
